

December 26 ~ Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph

Every parent can relate to this Gospel. The thought of a child getting lost, no matter their age brings anxiety and stress! The relief of Mary and Joseph is palpable in this passage even though the 12-year-old Jesus acts surprised about his parents' concern. However, what is most important to glean from this gospel is the fact that upon returning to Nazareth, Jesus "was obedient to them; and. . . Jesus advanced in wisdom and age and favor." Their years together provided important time for growth for the Holy Family. The vocation of parents, grandparents and guardians is both rewarding and challenging. Take time to think about the example of the Holy Family and let them be a source of strength for you and for all families.



Synod on Synodality

Over the coming months, Catholics from around the world will be participating in the Synod on Synodality. What does that mean? Here in Boston it means that we will be gathering, as parishes and as a diocese to pray together and to invite the Holy Spirit to help us to listen deeply to one another, and we will talk together about how best to do that. So, for instance, a parish council may get together and ask "How can we as a parish council do a better job of letting the voices of all our parishioners be heard, even those who are not a part of an inner circle or who might be marginalized for whatever reason?" The archdiocese and the church around the world will be engaging in the same sort of conversation. We pray that the Lord will open our hearts to Him and to all of our people.

Christmas is not over ... 12 Days of Christmas and 3 kings

"We three kings of Orient are
Bearing gifts we travel afar...
Following yonder star
We three kings, we three kings
Born a king on Bethlehem's plain...

The feast of manifestation, or Epiphany, is traditionally celebrated the 12th day after Christmas, January 6th. In the dioceses of the United States this feast has been moved to the Sunday between January 2 and January 8.

"Epiphany" means "manifestation" and it comes from Greek roots that mean "to show, to display" (phainein) and "on, to" (epi-). Thus, an epiphany is a time when something is shown, displayed, or manifested to an audience.

The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Son of God and Savior of the world. The feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men from the East, together with His baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast at Cana in Galilee (His first public miracle).

The magi were representatives of neighboring pagan religions who welcomed the good news of salvation through the Incarnation. These Wise Men, in coming to Jerusalem to pay homage to the King of the Jews showed that they sought, in Israel, the messianic light of the star of David, the one who would be King of the Nations. Summarily: all can discover Jesus and worship Him as God and Savior.

Can you see Christ in others? Do others see Christ in you through your thoughts, words and actions? Are you so full of joy that comes knowing, loving and serving God that others want to draw near to Him as well? Perhaps this can become your new years goal.

MLK Jr. Trip

For ten of the past eleven years, the youth of Saint Margaret Mary Parish have celebrated the Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday by collecting socks, hats, gloves, scarves, hand and feet warmers, men's toiletries, and gift cards for the homeless of Boston. 
