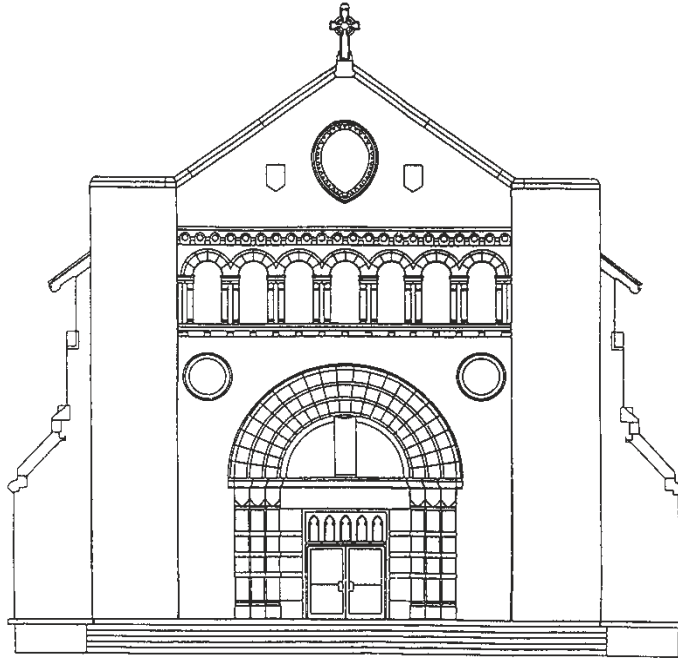

**FR. KRIS' KORNER**

There's a first time for everything; at the wedding feast at Cana Jesus performed his very first miracle. It was at the request of his mother that the reluctant Jesus changed the water into wine. We learn so much about Jesus and his mother. First, it was Mary who noticed that the newly married couple was in peril of profound embarrassment; their wine had run out and the wedding reception was far from being over. When Mary brought this to the attention of Jesus, he told her that he wasn't ready. She disregarded what he said and motioned to the waiter to do whatever Jesus told him to do. Jesus obediently followed her lead and changed the foul water (used for washing feet) into the finest wine. The Church shares this story as a reminder of the special relationship between Jesus and his mother. He will always act upon her request; thus elevating the Blessed Mother to the Church's greatest intercessor of prayer. We also learn how much Jesus loves us. His first miracle was not spectacular like raising someone from the dead or giving sight to the blind, he simply saved a young man and woman from embarrassment. No need of ours is too insignificant to bring before Jesus and his mother. Lastly, Mary nudged Jesus to perform his first miracle even though he felt he wasn't ready. Offer prayers for those people who believed in you and encouraged you to overcome fears or obstacles; and if you are able, let them know how instrumental they were in your life.

**SUNDAY SNOW POLICY FROM BISHOP TOBIN**

In light of snowstorms with dangerous conditions, Catholics of the Diocese of Providence are reminded to use prudence & extreme caution in deciding whether or not they are able to attend Sunday Mass. While the obligation to attend Holy Mass is always to be taken seriously, Catholics are not expected to attend Mass if the weather conditions are dangerous & extremely difficult. Personal safety should be a priority. Catholics are urged to observe directions issued by state and local officials during storms and if local conditions are dangerous, they may legitimately choose to stay home, remain safe & spend more time in personal prayer & reflection in keeping with the spirit of the Lord's Day.
