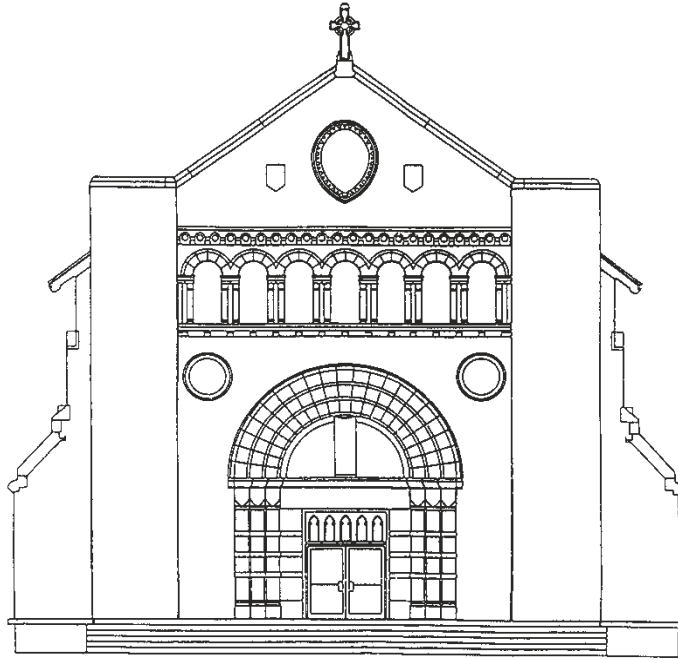

**FR. KRIS' KORNER**

From the time I was a teenager I have enjoyed reading and studying the bible. Although I don't have the kind of mind that remembers where a passage is located in the bible, but by God's grace I remember nearly everything I've ever studied about the scriptures. I soak up the stories of the bible and make them come alive by applying them to everyday life. Hopefully, during my homilies you've witnessed my joyful enthusiasm; I only pray that my enthusiasm for the scriptures is contagious. People often thank me for the messages I deliver in my homilies, however, the real credit goes to the Holy Spirit; I am merely a vessel proclaiming the Good News of Jesus Christ. The Word of the Lord is alive and has incredible power in and of itself. What role do the scriptures play in your life? Have you ever read or studied the bible? How have you been inspired, guided, challenged or comforted by the scriptures? Which scripture stories have touched your life? If you feel that you could use some improvement with your understanding of the scriptures, we offer **Adult Faith Sharing** on the first Saturday of every month from 9AM to 10AM in the parish center. This is a non-threatening, enjoyable time where we talk about one of Jesus' stories (parables) and apply it to our lives. There is no formal teaching and no one is ever quizzed on what they know. Everyone is welcome – you just need an open heart and a willingness to share your faith. If you would like to read the bible on your own but don't know where to start, you can find the daily and Sunday Mass readings online; simply search for Catholic Readings Bishops. It's very easy and there is a two minute mini-homily video each day. So, in the comfort of your own home and perhaps even in your jammies you can grow closer to our Lord at your own pace. God bless; it's a life-long journey of discovery and falling in love.

**SUNDAY SNOW POLICY FROM BISHOP TOBIN**

In light of snowstorms with dangerous conditions, Catholics of the Diocese of Providence are reminded to use prudence & extreme caution in deciding whether or not they are able to attend Sunday Mass. While the obligation to attend Holy Mass is always to be taken seriously, Catholics are not expected to attend Mass if the weather conditions are dangerous & extremely difficult. Personal safety should be a priority. Catholics are urged to observe directions issued by state and local officials during storms and if local conditions are dangerous, they may legitimately choose to stay home, remain safe & spend more time in personal prayer & reflection in keeping with the spirit of the Lord's Day.
