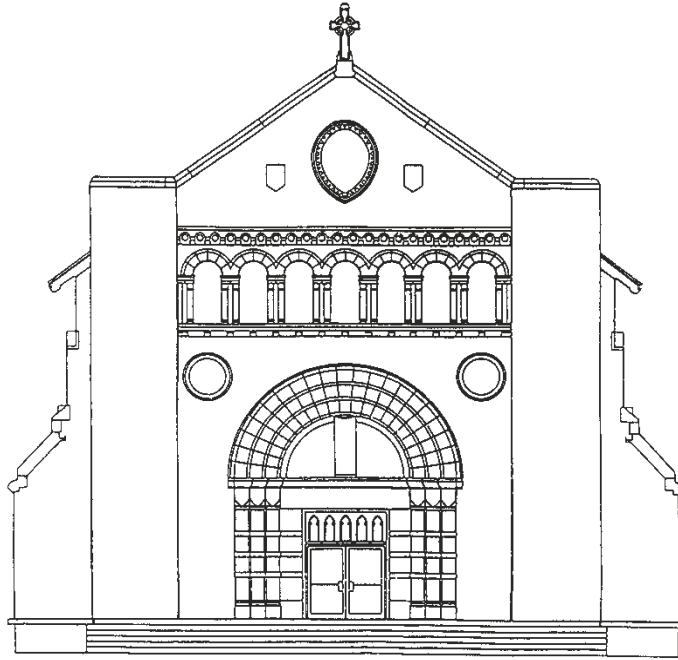

**FR. KRIS' KORNER**

In today's gospel, Jesus calls the first disciples to follow him with the famous words "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." These men were expert fishermen and had devoted their lives to the business; the work was exhausting and often kept them out at all hours of the day. Basically, it's all they knew. So, what was it about Jesus that convinced them to immediately leave everything behind and follow him? Might it have been that they caught the 'catch of a lifetime' due to Jesus' instructions? Well it certainly wasn't because they were afraid of him or that in his presence they felt sinful. So what was it that convinced them to give up their livelihood to commit themselves totally to Jesus? We may never truly understand. What is it that convinced (or continues to convince) you to commit to Jesus? Each of us has made many commitments throughout our lifetimes: education, sports, music, job/career, spouse, friends and family, just to name a few. But have you ever thought about your commitment to your faith? Do you stand firm in your commitment to Christ even when it proves to be inconvenient or difficult? Do other things habitually take priority over practicing your faith? What evidence is there in your life that you have made a commitment to Christ as a Catholic? Are you committed to faithful Mass attendance, service in the parish or in the community, a devout prayer life, intentionally using your life experience and God-given talents for the betterment of humanity? Start every day with a very simple prayer of recommitment: "Here I am Lord, help me not to be afraid to give myself entirely to you. Use me as your servant to spread the Good News in word and action."

**ARE YOU AN "ACTIVE" PARISHIONER?**

We are always trying to keep our parishioner records up-to-date. Updating our records saves the parish money by avoiding sending mail to incorrect addresses, to people who have moved away or to people who no longer want to hear from us. After a certain length of time, if we haven't heard from you, your household goes on the INACTIVE list and you may not receive important information or benefits from the parish. One way to ensure your active status is to use our **budget envelope system**. My mother refused to use budget envelopes her whole life because of her attitude "I don't want anyone knowing what I give." There are so many rewards to being a parishioner who's committed to being a part of a community of faith and to being responsible for the upkeep of our beautiful church. If you are not a budget envelope user, please ask yourself why and reconsider.
