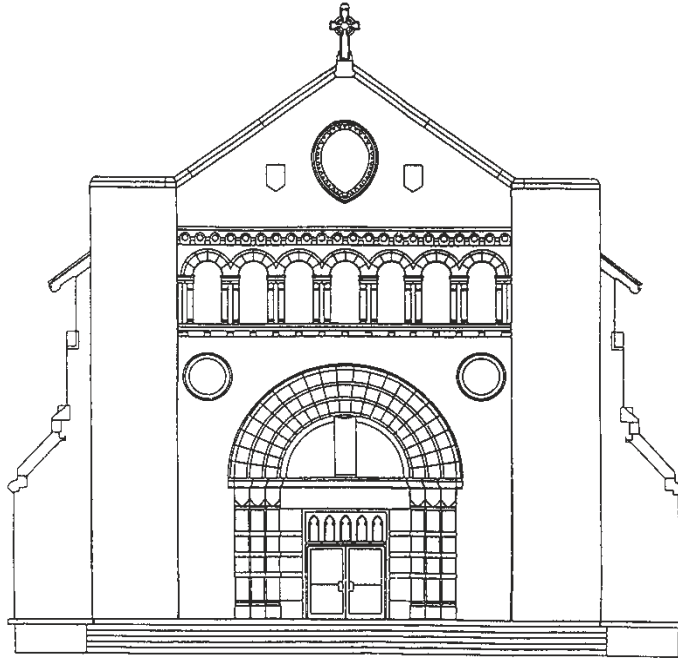

FR. KRIS' KORNER

In today's gospel Jesus warns us to choose our friends carefully. Jesus had twelve close friends but from them he chose three 'best friends'- Peter, James and John. Over the course of our lifetime we subconsciously 'interview' people for positions within our circle of friends. But how do we distinguish between a good and bad person? Jesus advises us "A good person, from the goodness of their heart, produces good. An evil person, from their stored up evil, produces evil." With every person we meet, without knowing it, we size them up, we ask questions such as: Would I like to get to know this person better? Does this person share my values and morals? Would I trust this person with my vulnerabilities? i.e. Would he/she make a good friend and a trusted confidant? As I said, we do this constantly; it's part of who we are as human beings, it's embedded in our DNA for our own safety. Some take more risks than others when it comes to making friends; some err on the side of caution and they form new relationships very slowly and put the new 'friend candidate' through a series of tests. With each test that the new friend passes he/she is invited deeper into one's inner circle. A failed test could mean 'danger, danger' and boundary lines must be set up that the person cannot cross. I quote from today's first reading "Praise no one before he speaks, for it is then that people are tested." Some people invite others into their lives far too readily, sharing too much too quickly and they end up getting hurt when they discover that the new friend cannot be trusted. And alas, it is devastatingly heartbreaking when a long-time friend breaks our trust – just think of Judas whom Jesus had befriended for three years. Every one of us has been or will be hurt by the risk to love; even Jesus, out of his love for us, paid the ultimate price with his life because we could not be trusted. And so we all navigate this life together, gathering friends and lovers to join us on our journeys through this life and beyond. **Choose wisely** and then when you have gathered a few special people into your inner circle of friends cherish them, shower your love upon them, be trustworthy, and be grateful to the Father that He has brought them into your life.

GUIDELINES FOR LENT

Lent runs from Ash Wednesday up to, but excluding, the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday.

Fasting: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are **days of fasting**: those between the ages of 18 and 59 should eat less, meaning, take no solid food between meals and only one full meal that day. Serious health conditions excuse a person from these precepts.

Abstinence: Abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent (for those 14 and older) is required by Church law.
