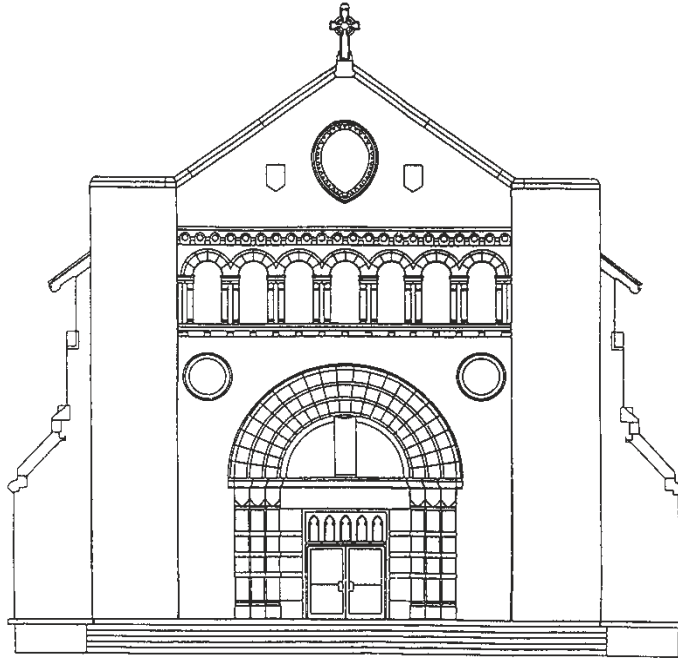

FR. KRIS' KORNER



Welcome to the first week of Lent. In today's Gospel, Jesus is tempted by the Devil but He resists his lies by quoting scripture. Jesus hadn't eaten in the desert for forty days so Satan tempted him by telling Jesus to turn stones into bread. How many of us get into trouble when life gets complicated and we take matters into our own hands, turning to sinful solutions and immediate gratification rather than trusting in God's good care and timing? Next Satan offers Jesus power and glory. The desire for power, fame and fortune can be subtle but left unchecked can turn one into a megalomaniac monster. History reminds us that many lives have been destroyed by those misusing their power. Lastly, Satan encourages Jesus to test God by putting Himself in danger to see if God will save Him. I'm certain that there have been many people who, in the act of committing a sin, have prayed "Dear Lord, please don't let me get caught and protect me from harm." We've all heard the saying "If you play with fire, you get burned." Once we cross that line of temptation there is no turning back; the sin will be committed, damage will be done, evil will cause havoc, loved ones will be hurt and lives, marriages, reputations, etc. will be ruined. Please be careful, Satan knows every trick in the book to lure you from holiness. Pray the *Our Father* at the first sign of temptation so that you may be able to resist by the grace of God. When we pray the *Our Father* we say "And lead us not into temptation..." however, it is never the Lord who leads us into temptation; we do a great job of it ourselves! Other than prayer or scripture, what else helps you resist temptation; considering the wounding effects on your loved ones, imagining the dreadful consequences of your words or actions, thinking that whatever the sin you want to commit is below your dignity as a child of God and as a decent human being? Sin is committed every second of every day and sadly, sin accumulates and can have devastating effects on individuals, families, communities, nations and even on our planet! SIN ALWAYS HAS CONSEQUENCES... RESIST!

GUIDELINES FOR LENT

Lent runs from Ash Wednesday up to, but excluding, the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday.

Fasting: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are **days of fasting**: those between the ages of 18 and 59 should eat less, meaning, take no solid food between meals and only one full meal that day. Serious health conditions excuse a person from these precepts.

Abstinence: Abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent (for those 14 and older) is required by Church law.
