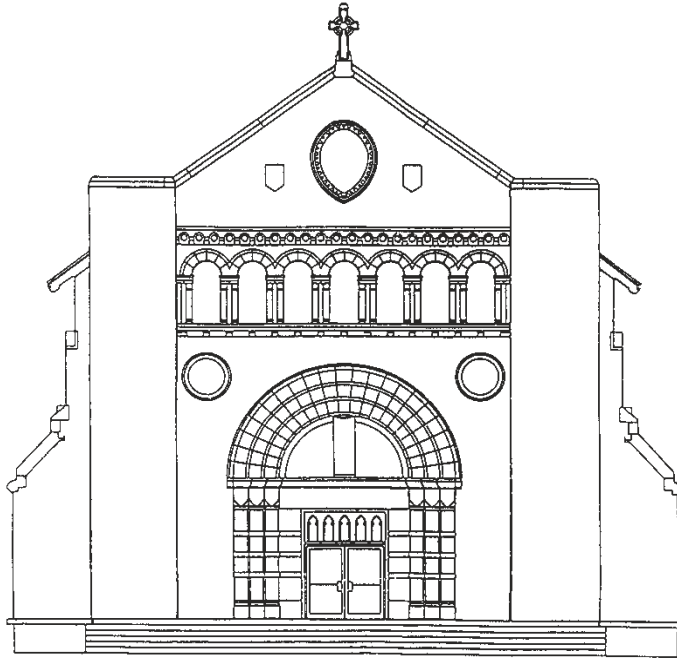

FR. KRIS' KORNER



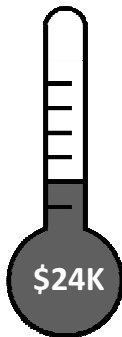
In the course of the Palm Sunday Mass we change our mood from "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord" to "Crucify Him! Crucify Him!" We start the Mass with Jesus' triumphal entry into the Holy City of Jerusalem, riding on a donkey and receiving a royal welcome as people waved their palm branches as He passed by them on the road. However, in just a matter of a few days the crowds turned completely against Jesus as He was publically humiliated as though He were a common criminal. They cheered "Crucify Him, Crucify Him" with a sickening delight. Why did they turn against him; how did He so deeply offend them? It is far too easy to criticize the crowds of Jesus' time. You may think that, if you were there, you would never have given into the crowd mentality; that somehow you would have been the only one to shout "I believe!" I've heard from many people who find it extremely uncomfortable to shout "Crucify Him, Crucify Him!" when we read the part of the crowd. Today, it seems to be socially acceptable and even encouraged to criticize or even condemn priests, bishops, the Pope, the entire Catholic Church, faith and religion in general. When you hear such conversations do you defend your faith, do you talk about God's love, do you talk about all that the Church has done for you and continues to do for the world? Are you brave enough to share Jesus' life, death and resurrection or do you just remain silent and watch as Jesus is condemned over and over again? Be brave and stand firm in your faith. We need you, more than ever, to cry out "I believe and I remain loyal to my Lord and King, Jesus Christ!"
