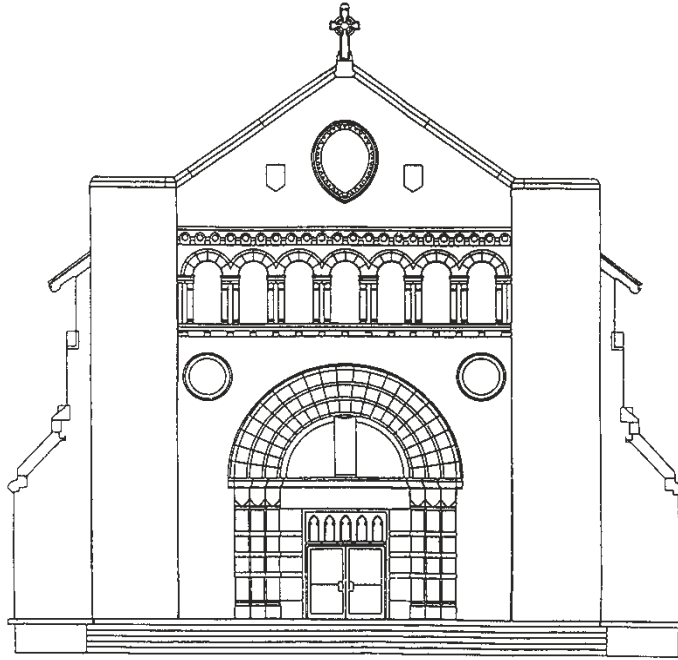

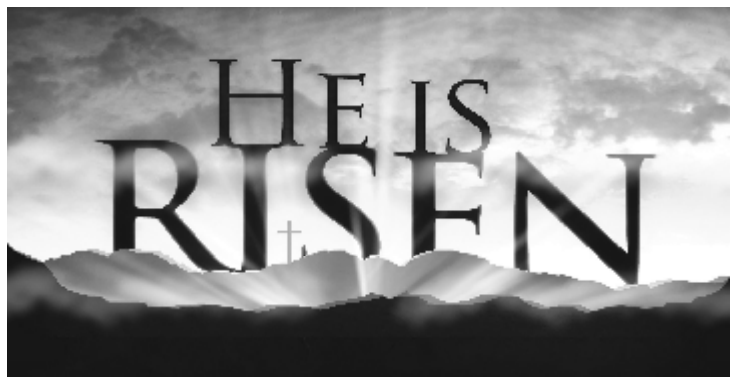

**FR. KRIS' KORNER**



On Easter morning children will be scurrying around looking for hidden Easter eggs, devouring the chocolate in their Easter baskets, and hoping to get a glimpse of the Easter Bunny. Sadly, for some, this is all they know of Easter; in their homes there is no mention of Jesus dying on the cross and certainly no mention of his resurrection. For many adults, the holiest day of the year is just another occasion to get together with family and friends. But for me and my family, it is the reason why we continue to be connected to four deceased members of my family. Six years ago on Easter Sunday, my father had a massive heart attack and, with only eight more days to live, he said he was honored to have his heart attack on the holiest day of the year. A year later my mother passed away from a bad fall. Three years ago my sister Lynn passed away unexpectedly from a heart attack a few days before Easter. Her heart wore out; perhaps it was because she poured her heart out every minute of every day by loving others. Then eleven days later my brother Jay passed away due to complications from alcoholism. My family held strong – we did not collapse in our grief. That year I delivered Easter homilies that were different from what I had ever given before. My faith – my hope in the Resurrection – kept me from unravelling; I imagined my parents were there to welcome my sister and brother into eternal life. On that first Easter morning, all time and eternity changed, all sins were forgiven, the gates of heaven were opened, and a completely new way of being was ushered into existence through Jesus Christ. I can't imagine life without this hope. Now, perhaps you can understand why I get perturbed that the Easter Bunny has taken over Easter. Have you tried to delve into the fullness of what Easter is all about? Have you taken time to reflect on how the Paschal Mystery (Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection) affects you personally? It takes work to make sense of it and to make it part of our lives; for most, it takes a lifetime... a lifetime of faith. May this Easter change your life forever for the Lord is risen, Halleluiah!

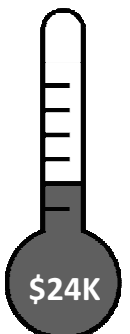
**ADULT FAITH SHARING—MAY 4**
