



FROM FATHER MARK:



Last Sunday, with the sun shining on such a beautiful day, I took my dog Mendl to Ocean Drive for our usual three mile walk. I took some time to pray and reflect on the upcoming events of this week; namely, my installation as pastor of St. Mary's Church and Saint Augustin Church. I thought about

the rich history of each parish, and the very thought was overwhelming. Our history begins in the early 1800s, with a request from Bishop Benedict Fenwick of Boston. Bishop Fenwick asked Father Robert Woodley to establish a Catholic church in Rhode Island. After investigating Providence and other locales in the state, Father Woodley chose Newport because the construction of Fort Adams was drawing scores of skilled and unskilled laborers from Ireland. The first Masses were celebrated in 1828, in what had been a schoolhouse on the corner of Barney and Mt. Vernon streets but within a few decades, a church had been commissioned, designed and built. On June 14, 1849, Bishop Bernard O'Reilly consecrated the Church of the Holy Name of Mary, Our Lady of the Isle—otherwise known as St. Mary's Church, An energetic and devout priest, Rev. James Fitton, was appointed the new church's first pastor. Over the following decades the community grew so large that by the turn of the century, another church was needed to accommodate the faithful. Parishioners answered the call, contributing their talents and resources, some actually joining the construction crew to make the church a reality. St. Augustin Church was located south of St. Mary's, in the heart of the Fifth Ward. A great many pastors have shaped and sustained these parishes since the days of Fr. Fitton. I have been fortunate to have met and known some of them. I trained under Rev. John McNulty of St. Augustin, shared my early years as a youth minister with Rev. Kris von Maluski, and am pleased to know that Rev. George McCarthy is just a phone call away should I need his help or advice.

It is a great honor to share in the rich history of St. Mary and St. Augustin. But I would be remiss if I did not say that these two parishes aren't solely the work of their pastors. Both also have been built on the ministries of the Sisters of Mercy, the Cluny Sisters, and the efforts and dedication of the past and present members of the Ancient Order of Hibernians. The dedication and commitment of past and present parishioners have left us the legacy that we now enjoy and must sustain for future generations.

I am the fourteenth pastor of St, Mary's since the early days of Rev. James Fitton. I never expected this charge to serve, and I pray I will be equal to the needs of this community.

I thank Bishop Tobin and Bishop Evans for your confidence and trust in me. I would also like to acknowledge a few people who have brought me to this moment. I am grateful to my mother, Marie, and my late father, Alexander Sauriol, who laid the foundation for my faith. My sister Donna her husband Joe and their four children have always been a great support for me. I have been blessed with many other family members and lifelong friends who are active in my life. Many priests and religious have been role models for me, including those previously mentioned. And I thank my former parishioners, who have shaped who I am today.

In a special way during the Installation Mass I hold in my heart the memory of Sister Josephine Leger, Guido Santilli, Richard Bucki, and Maryann Maciocio.

Last, but certainly not least, I thank all those who have come forward from St. Mary and St. Augustin during these last few weeks to offer support and guidance. For this I cannot help but feel blessed. I am blessed, too, to be your pastor. Please pray for me as we start a new chapter in the life of our parishes. You will be in my prayers.
