**GOSPEL MEDITATION
ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING
OF SCRIPTURE
July 14, 2019**

Loving isn't too difficult, right? Many of us are surrounded by kind, lovely people trying to do the right thing. Indeed, to "love? your neighbor as yourself" seems like it should be easy enough. Treat people like you would like to be treated. Bring the new neighbors some baked goods (normal and gluten-free, just in case). Chat with the bank teller about his holiday weekend. Write an occasional card to your sister "just because." There were probably varieties of these acts of kindness in Jesus' day. But "exchange pleasantries with the traveling cloth merchant" isn't the example Jesus gives.

"A man fell victim to robbers... they stripped him and beat him and went off leaving him half-dead." The righteous pass by the scene of the dying man. The hero of the story is the one on the margins of Jewish society, who perhaps would not have been welcomed, in other circumstances, by the man now in the ditch. His neighborly love causes him to halt his journey, to tend wounds, and to pay for the man's care out of his own savings. Are we interruptible? Are we attentive to the hurts of others? Are we generous with our money and possessions?

In the past few weeks, who has crossed your mind as someone in need of help? Perhaps it's an acquaintance suffering from cancer. Maybe you were invited to donate or volunteer to a local social cause, but it just won't stick in your mind (or schedule) to make it happen. The needs of people are many and varied. We can't help everyone, but God does place opportunities in our path for compassion and courageous love. This week, be "the one who treated him with mercy."

Amar no es demasiado difícil, ¿verdad? Muchos de nosotros estamos rodeados de gente amable y encantadora que trata de hacer lo correcto. De hecho, "amar a tu prójimo como a ti mismo" parece que debería ser bastante fácil. Trata a las personas como a ti te gustaría ser tratado. Traiga a los nuevos vecinos algunos productos horneados (normal y sin gluten, por si acaso). Charla con el cajero sobre su fin de semana festivo. Escribe una tarjeta ocasional a tu hermana "solo porque". Probablemente hubo variedades de estos actos de bondad en los días de Jesús. Pero "intercambiar bromas con el comerciante de telas que viajan" no es el ejemplo que da Jesús.

"Un hombre fue víctima de ladrones ... lo despojaron, lo golpearon y se marcharon dejándolo medio muerto". Los justos pasan por la escena del moribundo. El héroe de la historia es el que está al margen de la sociedad judía, que tal vez no hubiera sido bien recibido, en otras circunstancias, por el hombre que está ahora en la zanja. Su amor por el prójimo le hace detener su viaje, atender heridas y pagar el cuidado del hombre con sus propios ahorros. ¿Somos interrumpibles? ¿Estamos atentos a las heridas de los demás? ¿Somos generosos con nuestro dinero y posesiones?

En las últimas semanas, ¿quién se ha cruzado por su mente como alguien que necesita ayuda? Tal vez sea un conocido que sufre de cáncer. Tal vez fue invitado a donar o ser voluntario en una causa social local, pero simplemente no se quedará en su mente (o programa) para que esto suceda. Las necesidades de las personas son muchas y variadas. No podemos ayudar a todos, pero Dios coloca oportunidades en nuestro camino para la compasión y el amor valiente. Esta semana, ser "el que lo trató con misericordia".
