Historical Context – Pentecost

The word Pentecost comes from the Greek for fiftieth day. Pentecost Sunday ends the season of Easter and comes as a Sabbath day after seven weeks of seven days. In Jewish tradition the 50th day after the Passover was celebrated as a blessing of the harvest and rather than the unleavened bread of Passover it was celebrated by leavening the bread. It was for this reason that the disciples were gathered together when they experienced the Holy Spirit empowering them. In Christian tradition, Pentecost is celebrated as the arrival of the Spirit, promised by Jesus, that animated the disciples to spread the gospel of Jesus and gather believers to form what would eventually become the Church.

Reflection/Discussion Questions for Adults:

- What was different about Jesus breathing the Spirit on the disciples and the Pentecost experience
 - What was significant about the disciples being heard to speak in many different languages?
 - Why might Pentecost sometimes be regarded as the birth of the Church?
 - Have you ever had an experience of being aware of the Spirit's presence/action?
 - Where in your life could you use the guidance and strength of the Spirit?

Deacon Mike's Retirement

Deacon Mike Iwanowicz, ordained in 1976 with the history-making, first group of Permanent Deacons for the Archdiocese of Boston, began his affiliation with Our Lady of Sorrows Parish in 1982 when he and his wife Pat started participating in the life of the parish. This affiliation was strengthened in 1984 when Mike, while assigned to the Archdiocese of Boston's Family Life Apostolate, began serving at various parish liturgical and sacramental celebrations. This led to the Archbishop of Boston assigning Mike as the Permanent Deacon for Our Lady of Sorrows Parish in 1988. This assignment has continued to the present moment.

After being associated with the parish for over 30 years and serving as our assigned Permanent Deacon for 25 years, Mike has decided to retire on June 30, 2013. Though Mike will have the title "Senior Deacon" and maintain a relationship with the parish in his retirement, the Parish Staff has scheduled two opportunities for parishioners to acknowledge and thank Deacon Mike for his dedicated and faithful ministry to Our Lady of Sorrows Parish and the Archdiocese of Boston and to assure him of our prayers and best wishes for this next phase of his life.

Saint of the Week: Bernadine of Siena, May 20

Saint Bernadine was the son of the governor of Siena. He was orphaned at age six and was brought up by his aunt.

He became a Franciscan friar at the age of twenty-two and traveled all over Italy, preaching several sermons a day to large crowds. He is remembered for his devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus. At the end of his sermons, he would hold up for veneration a plaque on which he wrote IHS – the Greek translation of 'Jesus'. Through his preaching, Bernadine was responsible for introducing a vast number of people to Christianity. In 1437 he became the vicar-general of the Observant branch of the friars, during which time the number of Observants rose tenfold due to his popularity. After establishing theology schools for the friars, he returned to his favorite task of preaching at the age of sixty-three, but died a year later on the 20th of May.
