Deacon Mike Iwanowicz, ordained in 1976 with the history-making, first group of Permanent Deacons for the Archdiocese of Boston, began his affiliation with Our Lady of Sorrows Parish in 1982 when he and his wife Pat started participating in the life of the parish. This affiliation was strengthened in 1984 when Mike, while assigned to the Archdiocese of Boston's Family Life Apostolate, began serving at various parish liturgical and sacramental celebrations. This led to the Archbishop of Boston assigning Mike as the Permanent Deacon for Our Lady of Sorrows Parish in 1988. This assignment has continued to the present moment.

After being associated with the parish for over 30 years and serving as our assigned Permanent Deacon for 25 years, Mike has decided to retire on June 30, 2013. Though Mike will have the title "Senior Deacon" and maintain a relationship with the parish in his retirement, the Parish Staff has scheduled two opportunities for parishioners to acknowledge and thank Deacon Mike for his dedicated and faithful ministry to Our Lady of Sorrows Parish and the Archdiocese of Boston and to assure him of our prayers and best wishes for this next phase of his life.

### Staff Transitions for Faith Formation

Jackie Baldino, our Director of Faith Formation, will now serve both Our Lady of Sorrows Parish and Blessed Sacrament Parish in this role. She will

be supported by a Coordinator of Faith Formation at each parish and an Administrative Assistant, Deborah Lafleur, at Our Lady of Sorrows Parish. Jackie's strong educational and experience background will help her develop valuable faith formation programs that reflect the unique needs and desires of each parish. Jackie has shown a true vision for faith formation. We have been blessed to have her at our parish

and now are even more blessed because she will be able to expand her ideas and scope for the benefit of both Our Lady of Sorrows Parish and Blessed Sacrament Parish. This development is in line with the Archdiocese's collaborative direction. It will make our eventual formal collaboration with Blessed Sacrament Parish of Walpole and St. Mary Parish of East Walpole a little easier.

### Part-Time Coordinator of Faith Formation

Our Lady of Sorrows Parish is seeking a part-time coordinator of Faith Formation. This is a 20 hour per week position that includes regular weekend hours during the school year. The successful candidate will present a friendly, welcoming approach to working with parents of school age children and will be a responsible, self-motivated, detail-oriented adult. The work requires strong organizational and computer use skills. This position reports to the Director of Faith Formation who will provide the curriculum materials and direction for the program. This person will implement the religious education classes for grades Pre-K through eight including recruiting volunteer teachers and maintaining communication with parents and students. ### You have an opportunity to help foster literacy in El Salvador!

Jackie Baldino, Director of Faith Formation at Our Lady of Sorrows Parish, will be traveling to El Salvador June 29 – July 7 for a ten day literacy brigade through the organization SHARE El Salvador. During the ten day brigade, “brigadistas” will participate in revolutionary “Literacy Circles” program organized by Salvadoran youth, visit historical sites, learn about the popular education movement of El Salvador and be immersed in the Salvadoran culture of organizing.

The goal of the experience is to accompany Salvadorans as they improve literacy, which brings a package of benefits not only to an individual but to each family and to the entire community. Literacy opens the door to further education and empowerment on an individual and strategic organizing on a community level.

Jackie, along with SHARE El Salvador, is asking for monetary donations to support literacy in El Salvador. It costs approximately \$100 to free a person from illiteracy. This covers materials, trainings, support for staff and volunteers. Please note Jackie has already paid for the cost of her trip. ## Scriptural context – A woman wronged

Because Mary the Magdalene is named immediately after the event in the house of Simon the Pharisee, she has historically become associated with the sinful woman and indeed has been regarded as a prostitute. Whilst Mary is identified as having been cured of possession, she is in fact one of the financial supporters of Jesus' ministry. There is no reference to her being a prostitute, yet this mistaken identity has been firmly entrenched. It was not until 1969 that the Church officially recognized the distinctions between Mary Magdalene, Mary of Bethany and Luke's "sinful woman." She is now acknowledged as "the apostle to the apostles."

Reflection/Discussion Questions for Adults

- Why might Simon the Pharisee have invited Jesus to dinner?
  - Why are meal stories such important teaching events in the gospels?
  - How are the woman's actions of welcome and hospitality a sign of her faith?
  - Who are the people today who are overlooked and treated like Simon treats the sinful woman?
