Padre's Ponderings

Dear Parishioners,

This past week, staff from **BCI Computers** completed the installation of all equipment and software to enable professional livestreaming of our parish liturgies. I am grateful to their staff for walking us through the process and for gracefully managing some unexpected problems with the project. I am very grateful to the anonymous donor who made the project possible, which included the installation of the new screen and projector. I continue to receive positive comments regarding the screen and am grateful to hear so many more people singing along!

Some have asked why, with the dispensation to attend Sunday Mass having just been recently lifted, we are beginning to offer a livestreaming service *now*. I would have liked to have begun doing so sooner, but the project was met with unexpected delays. (And when we do things as a parish community, it's o.k. if we have to wait a bit in order for them to be done well.) Nonetheless, having studied best practices in other parishes, it has become clear that more and more church communities are investing in **digital content**. The livestreamed liturgies may be the first impression of our community for newcomers, seekers and the disaffected. It will mean that funerals, weddings, baptisms and first communions can be viewed by distant relatives and friends. And it will also mean that the sick or homebound will be able to remain virtually connected to the parish. Much like the use of the screen during Mass, the kinks will have to be worked out and it may take some time before we're able to get up and running. Please be patient with the process.

Some have also asked why, as COVID restrictions are being lightened, we are still restricting access to the front door. We have discovered throughout the reopening process that this method is safer to control traffic into the church. We still count everyone who is present for our own record-keeping purposes. All those who enter the church are still welcome to exit through whichever door is most convenient for them, but we will be able to maintain greater consistency by the use of a central entrance. Thank you for your understanding.

In other news, we welcome **Sister Nemesia Licayu** of the Franciscan Apostolic Sisters to speak at all Masses this weekend about her community's mission work. Welcome, Sister Nemesia!

The deadline to register for **Ocean Commotion** is tomorrow! Please visit our website ASAP. If you have children in grades K-6, they will not want to miss this!

Lastly, if you have never attended one of our **Praise & Worship** nights, now is your chance! This **Wednesday**, **June 23**, we will gather in the church at **7pm**. Victoria always directs a prayerful and gifted ensemble. These musicians will lead us in prayer and song in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed. Praise & Worship evenings have become very popular with our community and I hope you'll be able to join us.


