**NOVENA TO THE MIRACULOUS MEDAL AT
SAINT STEPHEN'S**

A Novena to the Miraculous Medal will be held at Saint Stephen Church beginning on Wednesday, **October 3rd at 6:30pm** and continuing for nine consecutive Wednesdays through November 28. All are welcome.

A novena is a journey of prayer consisting of nine specific "moments." During the Miraculous Medal Novena we pray for one another, seek to imitate the Virgin Mar's openness to God's will and deepen our appreciation of St. Catherine Labouré's spirituality.

Catherine Labouré (1806-1876) entered, at a young age, the Community of the Daughters of Charity, in Paris, France. She spent 40 years of her life working with the poor and the destitute. A series of mystical experiences are the origin of the Miraculous Medal. Today, millions of Catholics and non-Catholics alike draw inspiration and strength from this devotion and St. Catherine Labouré's example.

The Novena service at 6:30 pm is a simple, brief service consisting of hymns, prayers, a short reflection concluding with veneration of the relic of Saint Catherine Labouré. Join with us in prayer!

**PARISH OFFICES FOR SAINT STEPHEN &
HOLY FAMILY PARISHES**

The parish offices for both Saint Stephen and Holy Family Parishes are located at 20 Hamilton Street in the building that formerly housed the Thrift Store. Theresa O'Brien is the office administrator for both St. Stephen's and Holy Family Parishes. The office hours are generally 10:00 am- 4:00 pm, Monday-Thursday. Of course, it is always a good idea to call the office first before coming in order to assure that someone will be there when you arrive. If you leave a message on the answering machine over the weekend, it will be returned as soon as possible on Monday. The parish offices are closed on civic holidays.

The parish offices located at 20 Hamilton Street include space for the **Brazilian** and **Haitian** communities (which worship at St. Joseph's) and the **Spanish-speaking** community which worships at St. Stephen's.

These changes are being made with a view to fiscal responsibility as well as enabling greater collaboration between **all four** cultural/ language communities, which now comprise our two parishes here on Grafton Hill. We thank you for your patience and understanding as we make these transitions and strive to work together as a Catholic community.

**ST. FRANCIS HOME CHAPEL RE-
DEDICATION ON OCT 4th**

On Thursday, October 4th, the Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi, we will gather at 10:30 am at the Saint Francis Home to celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving as we note the completion of the chapel renovation. As part of the Mass, the new chapel crucifix will be blessed. This crucifix is a replica of the **San Damiano Cross**, the one before which St. Francis was praying when he is said to have received his vocation from Christ to "re-build" the church. Franciscans cherish this cross as the symbol of their mission. The cross, with Christ's outstretched arms, beckons us to welcome the poor, the sick, and the unloved with the compassion which St. Francis lived. *All are welcome to join us for this joyous occasion!*

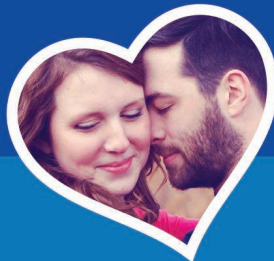
