NOVENA TO THE MIRACULOUS MEDAL AT SAINT STEPHEN'S

Our Novena to the Miraculous Medal is held at Saint Stephen Church on Wednesdays at 6:30pm and continues for nine consecutive Wednesdays through November 28—the Feast of Saint Catherine Labouré. All are welcome.

A novena is a journey of prayer consisting of nine specific “moments.” During the Miraculous Medal Novena we pray for one another, seek to imitate the Virgin Mary’s openness to God’s will and deepen our appreciation of St. Catherine Labouré’s spirituality.

Catherine Labouré (1806-1876) entered, at a young age, the Community of the Daughters of Charity, in Paris, France. She spent 40 years of her life working with the poor and the destitute. A series of mystical experiences are the origin of the Miraculous Medal. Today, millions of Catholics and non-Catholics alike draw inspiration and strength from this devotion and St. Catherine Labouré’s example.

The Novena service at 6:30 pm is a simple, brief service consisting of hymns, prayers, a short reflection concluding with veneration of the relic of Saint Catherine Labouré. Join with us in prayer!

PRAYER TO SAINT MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL

In response to Pope Francis’ appeal that we exercise “the gentle power of prayer” as the Church faces so many challenges, both internal and external, Bishop McManus has asked that the Prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel be recited at the conclusion of Masses throughout the Diocese of Worcester

The text of the prayer which the Church has prayed in turbulent times since it was composed by Pope Leo in 1886 is as follows:

“Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do Thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits, who prowl through the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.”

THE SOLEMNITY OF ALL SAINTS, NOVEMBER 1st**A HOLYDAY OF OBLIGATION**

Thursday, November 1st is the celebration of the triumph of grace in every person who now enjoys the eternal vision of God in heaven. All Saints Day is a reminder that the saints are beyond counting. It is a Holyday of obligation in our liturgical calendar.

A very small portion of these men and women have been publically recognized (“canonized”), but the great majority have not. Heaven is full of souls we do not know. Among them are surely members of our families and loved ones who have helped us in living the way of faith, hope and love. On All Saints Day we give thanks for the great “cloud of witnesses” (Hebrews 12:1) that surrounds us. We pray for the grace to imitate their virtues in our lives. We look forward to the day when all creation will be transformed and we will be joined to that great multitude of men and women who down through the centuries have given witness to Christ in varied and diverse ways. ALL SOULS’ DAY IS NOVEMBER 2nd

Friday, November 2nd is the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed-All Souls’ Day. It is the Church’s remembrance of those who have gone before us in death but who may be still in need of our prayers.

The scriptures teach us to pray for one another. Prayer joins us to Christ and to each other. Through prayer, love is diffused throughout the Body of Christ, even to those who have passed beyond this world and who are being purified before reaching the fullness of God’s eternal presence. Through God’s providence, the departed, who are on this journey are assisted by our prayers. **Mass for the Feast of All Souls will be celebrated on Friday, November 2nd at Notre-Dame Cemetery Chapel at 162 Webster Street in Worcester at 12:15 pm. The schola for the Mass will be under the direction of Lucia Clemente Falco. Fr. LaBaire will be the celebrant.** All are welcome. Mass will also be celebrated at the usual time of 8:30 am at St. Stephen Church on November 2nd.

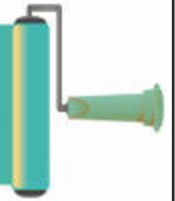
