TODAY IS GAUDETE SUNDAY

The Third Sunday of Advent is called "Gaudete Sunday." The word *Gaudete* is a Latin word meaning "to rejoice."

During Advent, we not only prepare to celebrate the first coming of Christ through his humble birth in Bethlehem, we reflect upon his Second Coming as well. Often, Christ's Second Coming, at the end of time, is described in frightening terms, as if it were to be dreaded. But for Christians who persevere in faith and love, there is nothing to fear or dread. Christ's Second coming at the will be the final victory of good over evil.

The earliest Christians would often say, Maranatha! Come, Lord Jesus! The phrase expressed their hope-filled faith that Christ would meet them at the end of time but that he was already meeting them in the Eucharist and in the people they encountered in their daily lives. Advent is an opportunity to pray and reflect upon all the ways that Christ comes to us: As the long awaited Savior, born in Bethlehem; as Judge and King at the end of the ages; as the Shepherd of Souls, through the Sacraments, here and now. On this Sunday, the rose colored candle is lit on the Advent Wreath. The Mass vestments are either rose or violet. While violet is the color of the Advent Season, rose is a softening of violet. On the color spectrum, rose is violet approaching white. Hence the color rose anticipates the white color of the Christmas liturgy. Thus, even while we wait, we are given a foretaste of the joy to come. We wait in joy to celebrate Christ's birth. We wait in joy for his Second Coming, at the end of time.

The colors of the Advent liturgy remind us that the spiritual life of a Christian is one of joyful anticipation. To be Christian is to allow oneself to be "colored" by hope. How are you "coloring" the events of your life with hope?
