Dear Parishioners,

Merry Christmas to you and yours! I pray everyone is having a good holiday season, and hopefully even a restful one. These past couple years have presented us with many challenges, and the holidays tend to accentuate how we are feeling. We may be feeling the pain of loss and/or sickness, the stress of trying to pay the bills, or even just an overall fear of illness and the state of the world. Yet our faith teaches us that where evil abounds, grace abounds all the more. I always recommend that we read scripture, and with recent helps such as the TV show “The Chosen”, we are able to imagine other times in history and what our ancestors in the faith may also have endured. For example, we first truly learn about hope from first century Jews and Christians who faced horrible oppression, and yet being overflowed with the Holy Spirit, overcame impossible odds. Despite hardship and persecution, their joy and their strength was Jesus, the Promised Messiah. Having heard the Christmas story for almost five decades of my life, I try to go deeper into the details that only a cursory reading leaves out, such as the dangers faced by the Holy Family in traveling from one town to another. Risks abounded, yet God the Father, the Author of History, wrote His story flawlessly and protected His chosen people. As we complete a year in honor of Saint Joseph, I feel a growing trust in many of us in Jesus’ Holy Family and the Trinity. Our loving Father has plans for each of us that end in our salvation, and He asks us to follow Him closely, as He will guide us through every challenge and increase our faith and inner peace at every turn. May God, through our Blessed Lady and her Spouse, fill your hearts now and always with an increase of wisdom, courage, and a joy that never ends!

Al completar un año en honor a San José, siento una confianza creciente en muchos de nosotros en la Sagrada Familia de Jesús y la Trinidad. La Navidad es un tiempo litúrgico que va desde las primeras vísperas de Navidad (el 24 de diciembre), y concluye con la Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor.



“Después de cuatro semanas de preparación en Adviento para este evento tan importante en la historia de la humanidad, toda la Iglesia y el mundo cristiano están llenos de alegría y gratitud a la Santísima Trinidad, a la Madre María y a San José, ya que finalmente se conmemora el nacimiento de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey y Salvador”.

la Navidad no es solo un día, sino una temporada completa que dura desde la víspera de Navidad, el 24 de diciembre, hasta la fiesta del Bautismo del Señor (**generalmente el domingo después de la Epifanía**).

Los miércoles tenemos el grupo de oración para los jóvenes ***"Entrando a lo profundo"*** que es un grupo de oración juvenil, donde se profundiza en los aspectos de la fe y se explora lo que significa ser católico para poder vivirlo.

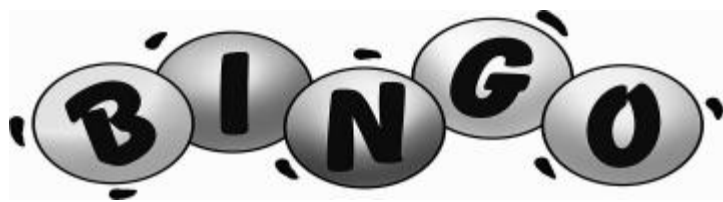

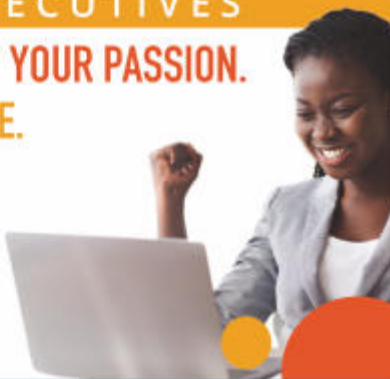
