**St. Nicholas**

St. Nicholas was born in Patara, now Turkey and raised to be a devout Catholic. His wealthy parents died in an epidemic when Nicholas was very young. He obeyed Jesus' words to "sell what you own and give to the poor" and used his entire inheritance to assist the needy, sick and suffering. He dedicated his life to serving God. He is known for his generosity to those in need. Also, for his love of children and concern for sailors and ships. Under the Roman Emperor, Bishop Nicholas suffered for his faith, was exiled and imprisoned. After his release, Nicholas attended the Council of Nicaea in 325 AD. He died December 6, 343 AD in Myra and buried in his cathedral church. The anniversary of his death became a day of celebration, known as St. Nicholas Day, December 6. Several stories tell of Nicholas and the sea. When he was young, Nicholas sought the holy by making a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. There as he walked where Jesus walked, he sought to experience Jesus' life, passion, and resurrection. St. Nicholas is the patron of sailors and voyagers. Other stories tell of Nicholas saving his people from famine and much more. He did many kind and generous deeds in secret, expecting nothing in return. Within a century of his death, he was celebrated as a saint and venerated a miracle worker and a patron of a great variety of people and known as the friend and protector of all in trouble or need. Known for countless miracles and generosity, St. Nicholas continues as a model for the compassionate life. St. Nicholas' feast day is kept alive with stories of his goodness and generosity and still the main day for gift giving and merrymaking in much of Europe. Simple gift giving in early Advent helps preserve a Christmas Day focus on the Christ Child.
