First Thursday at St. John Church Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament February 3, 2022 @ 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM

Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine, saying "this is my Body" and "this is my Blood", Catholics have believed that the consecrated bread and wine are no longer bread or fermented grape juice but the actual living presence of the second person of the Holy Trinity.

Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion is exactly the same as spending time before the living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass or in a more focused way, and when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration.

You are welcome on this coming Thursday to adore the Savior and bring blessings on you and on our community.
