

It sounds like there may be some good news about the Omicron variant being less severe, which some are saying could indicate that this pandemic is finally winding down. We've been through so many ups and downs that I think we're all a bit hesitant to get our hopes up, but I'm certainly praying that we will find some relief from this in 2022. We have been contending with all the turmoil and anxiety surrounding Covid-19 for almost two years, which is an especially long time for children and young people.

I hope you are looking forward to 2022 like I am. Of course we have no idea what lies in store for us, but with Christ leading us and support we receive in one another, we have every reason to be a people of hope. Happy New Year to you and your families!






