


# Our Lady of Good Counsel

## SACRAMENT OF HOLY BAPTISM FOR CHILDREN-

Parents wishing to have their child baptized should contact the parish office. Prior to the actual celebration of the sacrament there is a catechesis for parents on the meaning of baptism and Christian parenting.

## SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION FOR ADULTS-

## UNDERSTANDING OUR LITURGY PART NINE: THE PASCHAL (EASTER) CANDLE

During the 50 Days of the Easter Season, the Paschal Candle stands prominently at the head of the center aisle, at the entrance to the sanctuary.

The Easter candle is prepared and blessed during the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night when the church celebrates Christ's passing from death to life. Once lit, from the fire prepared outside the church, the candle is brought in procession into the church. The light of the Risen Christ illuminates the darkness of the night and enlightens the church.

You will notice that there is a **cross** on the Easter Candle. There are also **five nails** inserted into the wax. The cross represents the instrument of Christ's death. The nails represent the five wounds on Christ's crucified and risen body.

Above and below the cross are the Greek letters **Alpha** and **Omega**. These are the first and the last letters of the Greek alphabet. Between these letters are the numerals of the current year—**2021**. The juxtaposition of these numerals and letters convey that the victory of Christ is eternal: "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end" (Rev 22:13).

At the conclusion of the Easter Season, after the final Mass of Pentecost Sunday, the Easter Candle is moved from the sanctuary to a place near the Baptismal font where it will be lit at every Baptism. It will also be placed next to the casket of the deceased during a funeral Mass. Hence, the candle will remind us that through Baptism we are called to share in Christ's victory, though a life of discipleship. With death of every Christian, we celebrate his or her passing to a new life-in the pattern of Christ himself. Our Easter Candle eloquently (albeit silently) proclaims our Easter faith: This "pillar" of light" towering over us, reminds us that "God's grace is taller than us, bigger than us, greater than us." The bright victory of the Risen Christ beckons each of us.

### LEGACY OF HOPE CAMPAIGN

Our parish is now participating in the diocesan **Legacy of Hope Campaign**. Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish is part of a final group of parishes participating.

Already our neighbors at Saint Richard's in Sterling, Saint Mary's in Jefferson, Saint Rose of Lima in Northborough and Saint Mary's in Shrewsbury have successfully participated in this endeavor.

**Legacy of Hope** has been launched in recognition of the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of the Diocese of Worcester. It is intended to help shape the future of the Catholic community throughout Worcester County and here at our home at Our Lady of Good Counsel.

The campaign seeks to support our retired priests, parish-based Charitable Outreach and Evangelization, the Cathedral of Saint Paul, and most importantly, our own parish needs.

**We do have a number of issues that need to be addressed on the parish property: the front church steps, front walkway and the north side (town common side) exterior church entrance steps are in urgent need of repair. The church steeple is deteriorating and the chimes no longer function properly. The church chimney needs to be re-pointed. The parking lot entrance door to the church needs to be completely replaced. Water damage has warped the transom and damaged the foundation. Many parishioners have commented that after 35 years, the church interior could use a fresh repainting. Beyond all this, our parish hall could certainly use repainting and repairing as well.**

Neither our present parish resources nor the sale of the property on Church Street will cover the expenditures required to address all our needs. However, with careful prioritization of our needs, prudent use of our present resources, along with a generous response to the **Legacy of Hope**, we can attend to the lion's share of our challenges.

A parish is certainly more than buildings! But we cannot ignore the buildings either. Like a home, they provide a place for us to gather. Our parish church was built through the sacrifices of those who have gone before us. Now we have an opportunity to uphold the legacy.

More information will be shared during the upcoming weeks. There will be opportunities for questions and answers pertaining to all aspects of the campaign. It is important that those who participate feel confident about how the funds will be used and that there be a clearly defined plan and timetable as to what needed parish projects will be undertaken first.

Job skills and requirements: A regular participant in the life of the church being familiar with the rhythm and patterns of parish life; ability to collaborate closely with the pastor; an ability to communicate effectively with a variety of "publics," including other parish staff/ministers, business vendors, community leaders and parishioners with various needs and requests both in-person, via phone and by internet; computer skills in Microsoft Word, Access, Excel; willingness to learn ParishSoft computer platform; ability to work with specific deadlines; attentiveness to detail.


