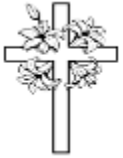

CLOSEUP ON SAFETY: HOSTS

You should know how the hosts are carefully placed in the ciborium, the special container for the hosts, and the practices for handling the ciborium. First, the ciborium itself is washed with warm water and soap before each Mass. Once dry, the hosts that are in a plastic sleeve are carefully dropped from the sleeve into the ciborium; the hosts slide out of the plastic sleeve so that the hosts are not touched by anyone. If the hosts arrive to our church in a container, the container is tipped over for the desired number of hosts without anyone touching hosts.

Then, a lid is placed on the ciborium. The lid remains on for your safety until right before communion is to be served. Before the priest descends the stair(s) to serve communion, he puts a mask on. Then, he carries the ciborium carefully to the table in the front of the sanctuary. Once the ciborium is placed on the table, the priest sanitizes his hands. With his palms, the priest removes the lid so that his fingertips have touched nothing before taking up the consecrated host that he will give you.

Sometimes, you will notice that the priest stops the distribution in order to re-sanitize his hands. This happens when the priest has accidentally touched the hand or finger of a communicant -- there will be more on this phenomenon next week.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel, the Shepherdess of Podhale, Nowy Targ, and St. John Paul II:

How this devotion connects our parish's past and its future.

For most of us who are the Church of St. Adalbert, the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel sparks pleasant memories of the Festa at our sister parish. Some have some knowledge of and devotion to the Flower of Carmel and the Brown Scapular. And yet, this feast and this devotion has a strong connection to the folks who founded this parish.

The connection begins in the Polish village of Ludźmierz just six miles outside the town of Nowy Targ. About one half of the original families of our parish were from Nowy Targ and the surrounding area. Nowy Targ lies on the main trade road from Kraków that climbs over the Tatra Mountains to Slovakia and Hungary. It had a bustling trade as it was a "free trade zone" from well back into the Middle Ages.

Legend has it that a merchant got lost and prayed for help. A woman, who was dressed in shepherdess garb, carrying a child led him to safety at a spot with a flowing spring. Then she and the child disappeared. The man had a statue made and a chapel built in thanksgiving. The woman with child looked very much like Mother Mary depicted in artwork of Our Lady of Mount Carmel whom he was familiar with and, therefore, that is how Our Lady of Ludźmierz is portrayed but clothed as the herding folks of the area around Nowy Targ.

The devotion to the Shepherdess of the People has been a strong one among the Polish people for over six centuries. The shrine-chapel to Our Lady attracted pilgrims from Slovakia, Hungary, and beyond. The pilgrims would have passed through Nowy Targ on their way to the shrine and would no doubt had seen the advertising by a Polish merchant and one of the founders of our parish who had settled in Schenectady. His notices told of the jobs available at GE and ALCO as well as the fine housing available in the Weaver Street neighborhood near his store.

As a child, Karol Wojtyła and his family made annual pilgrimages to the Marian shrine at Ludźmierz. It was here that he learned the Carmelite spirituality and through it came drawn to the priesthood. He made trips every year until he was elected pope and one during his papacy.

So just as Our Lady guided our forebears to these shores, a child to his saintly destiny as Supreme Shepherd of the Church, and so many others in so many ways over the years may we seek to grow closer in our spiritual/devotional life with Our Lady of Mount Carmel and Our Lady of Ludźmierz. May she guide us as we journey together as a parish family.
