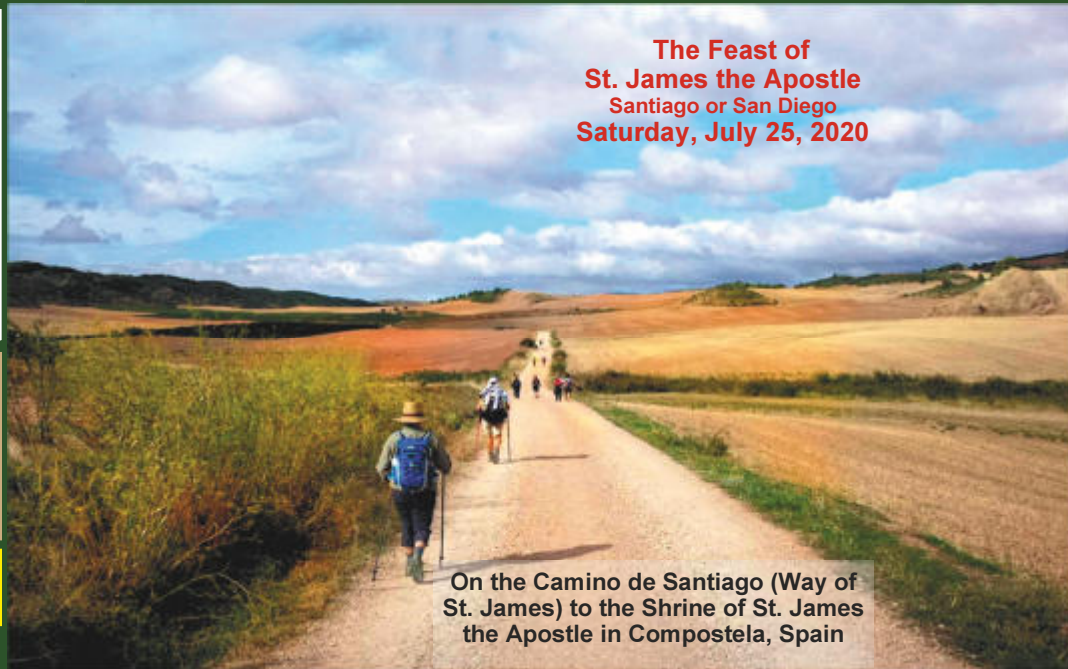

## CLOSEUP ON SAFETY: NO GRABBING!

When the priest puts the ciborium down on the table, he sanitizes his hands and then serves communion.

To save time for everyone, please do not grab the sacred Host of our Lord. For those who receive, place one hand flat over the other, as much as your health permits. Let the priest place the host in your flat hand (to prevent the host from rolling onto the ground), and then take up the host to receive. Pinching or grabbing the host before the priest has placed the host in your hand increases the risk that he touches your hand or finger. This wastes time for everyone, because the priest then needs to re-sanitize his hands again with the alcohol solution.

Please be mindful of who is being placed in your hand at the time of communion; be calm and gentle when taking up the Lord in this sacred moment.

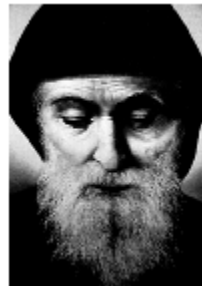

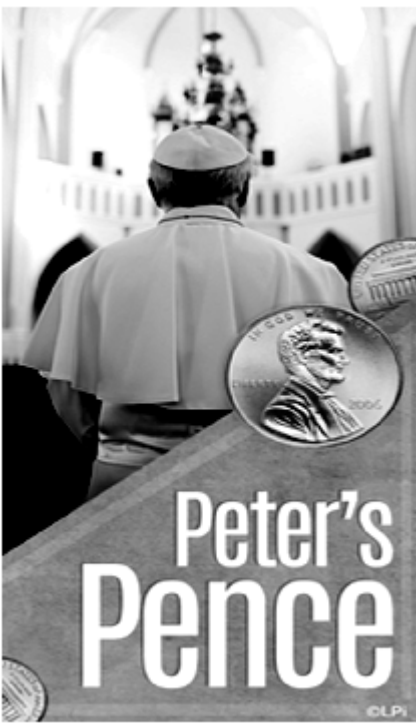

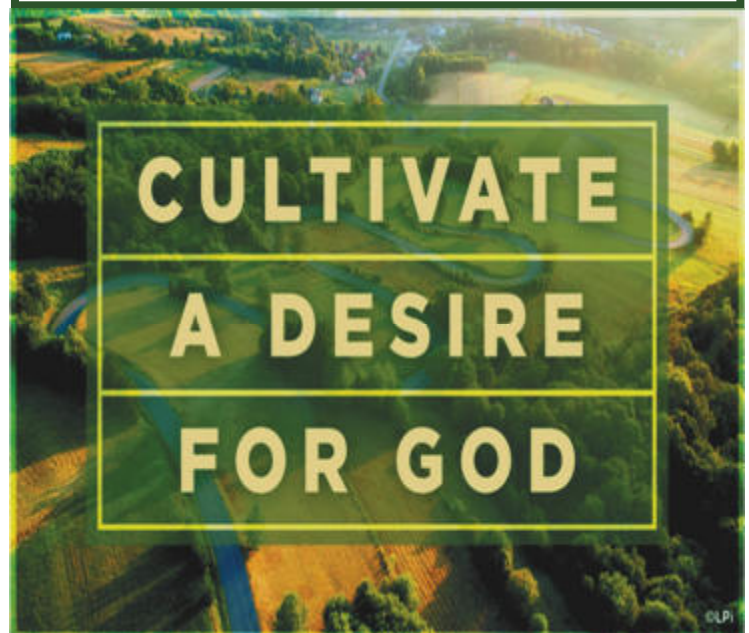
