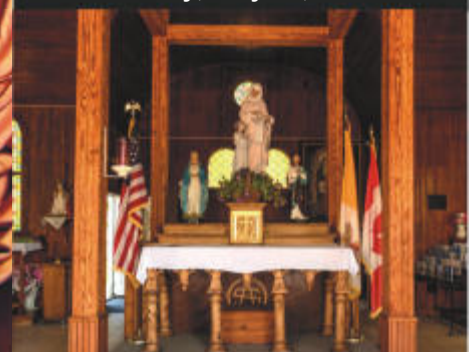

**The Feast of Sts. Joachim & Anne
Sunday, July 26, 2020**

One of the Church of St. Adalbert's most cherished traditions has been the annual celebration of the Feast of Sts. Joachim & Anne, parents of Jesus' Mother Mary. The celebration, which was originally sponsored by our parish's Altar-Rosary Society, included

participation in daily Mass with devotions after Communion over a 3 day period and concluded with a Communion Breakfast after Mass on the final day.

As we are unable to celebrate this feast together, we are encouraging you to pray it at home with family and/or friends. Begin with the prayer on the cover and continue with the prayers printed below:

PRAYER TO SAINTS JOACHIM AND ANNE FOR THE SICK

O Good Saints Joachim and Anne, you know how sacred suffering is. In its presence, we feel powerless. We would like to save our sisters, brothers, and ourselves from it. Like Jesus in Gethsemane, we say: "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass me by." In these words, we see how close Jesus is to all who suffer. Jesus tells us, "Come to me, all you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you."

Today, Saints Joachim and Anne, united in faith and in confidence, we ask Jesus to be with all who suffer. With you, we ask him to comfort and cure them. With you, we ask Him to help us say with faith: "Not my will, but yours, be done."

Saints Joachim and Anne, bless and care for our sick by embracing them with the love and mercy of Jesus and your own tenderness. Amen.
