



## Roman Catholic Diocese of Albany As of December 13, 2021 Mask-Wearing Protocols for Parishes

Governor Kathy Hochul on Dec. 10 announced a statewide mandate requiring face masks to be worn by everyone in all indoor public places unless business or venues have implemented a COVID-19 vaccine requirement. We believe the mask mandate is the most efficient option for parishes of the Diocese of Albany to remain compliant.

The mandate, as issued by the New York State Department of Health, is effective December 13, 2021-January 15, 2021, at which time the state will reassess its effectiveness based on COVID-related public health conditions.

## **Parish Offices**

Parish office staff and visitors are required to wear masks at all times except when eating, drinking or alone in an enclosed room.

#### Churches

All parishioners will be asked to wear masks while in church, in accordance with the state mandate that masks be worn in all "public places." Houses of worship are considered public places per state's definition.

Those who are involved in distributing Holy Communion during Mass are required to wear a mask during this distribution.
