

# IMPORTANT!

### Roman Catholic Diocese of Albany As of December 13, 2021 Mask-Wearing Protocols for Parishes

Governor Kathy Hochul on Dec. 10 announced a statewide mandate requiring face masks to be worn by everyone in all indoor public places unless business or venues have



implemented a COVID-19 vaccine requirement. We believe the mask mandate is the most efficient option for parishes of the Diocese of Albany to remain compliant.

The mandate, as issued by the New York State Department of Health, is effective January 15, 2022-February 1, 2022, at which time the state will reassess its effectiveness based on COVID-related public health conditions.

### **Parish Offices**

Parish office staff and visitors are required to wear masks at all times except when eating, drinking or alone in an enclosed room.

### Churches

All parishioners will be asked to wear masks while in church, in accordance with the state mandate that masks be worn in all "public places." Houses of worship are considered public places per state's definition.

Those who are involved in distributing Holy Communion during Mass are required to wear a mask during this distribution.

HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM -HEAP can help incomeeligible households pay the cost of home heating. Regular HEAP opened on October 1, 2021 and Emergency HEAP opened January 3, 2022. Both are scheduled to run through March 15, 2022. Program dates may be shortened or extended based on federal funding and demand. If you are eligible, you may receive one Regular HEAP benefit per program year and may also be eligible for Emergency HEAP benefits if you're in danger of disconnection. You can apply for the Regular HEAP benefit online at myBenefits.ny.gov/begin for more information on all HEAP benefits.
