Dear Parishioners,

Our first week of the academic year went off quite smoothly. The students are acclimating to the mask wearing, extra hand washing, and safety protocols well. We've been ironing out the kinks with drop off and pick up, but I expect things will run even better next week. I think Mei Li has had the hardest adjustment. The kids tell me that they see my dog sitting in the window as they drive in every morning. Since I got her just before Covid hit, she's not used to so much activity on campus.

We have filled up several of the classes. There are limited number of available seats in Prek 3, Prek 4, Kindergarten, 2nd, 6th, & 7th grades. Grades 1, 3, 4, 5, and 8 are all full. We did receive some good news for our Early Childhood Program (Prek 3, Prek 4, and K). If the governor pulls us back from Phase 3 and schools are forced to go distance learning, but day care centers are still allowed to open, our Early Childhood Program will be able to remain "in-person" learning at the school with some modifications and adjustments to group sizes. As our Early Childhood Program utilizes so much hands learning and activities, this accommodation really serves the best interests of our youngest learners. Hopefully, it won't be necessary. But it's good to know that this important phase of childhood development will be able to continue if the situation does arise.

I will be meeting with Mrs. Perry in the coming weeks with regard to our Religious Education Program. CCD families received a survey earlier in the summer regarding online classes or home study for religious education. Because of the safety protocols, we are not able to have groups of people use the classrooms on Sundays. We will certainly be in contact with families as we work out the plan for this academic year.

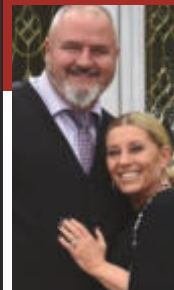
