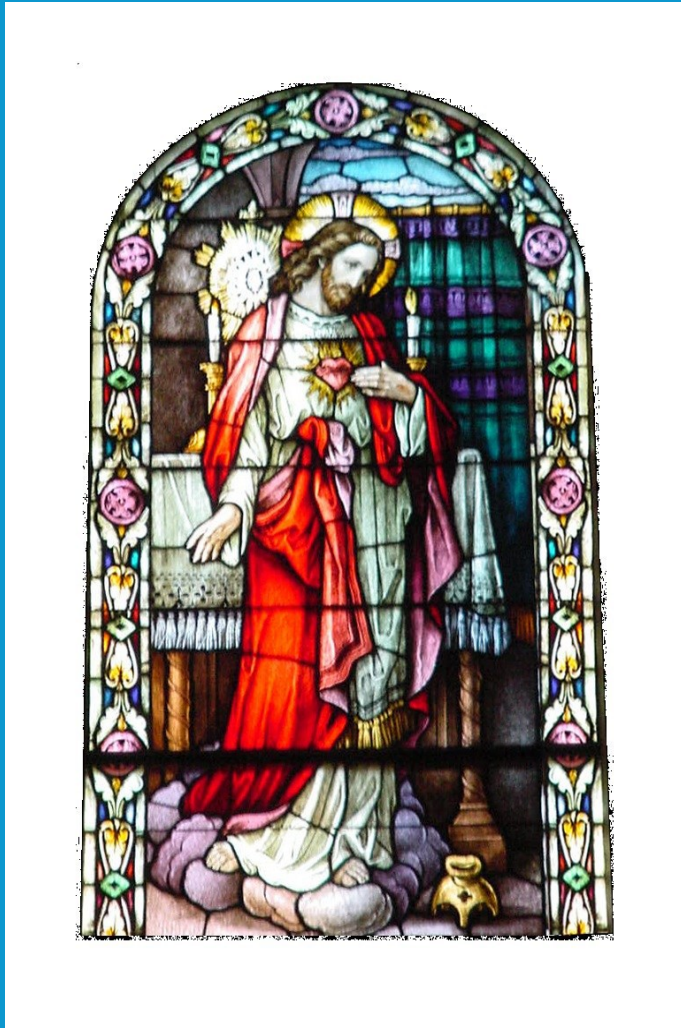

## ***FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:***

Normally I write this column from my desk where I look at Main Street when I am thinking, but this Tuesday I am looking out from a third story window onto an expansive lawn with many very mature trees and three young deer. I am at the seminary of the Immaculate Conception in Huntington, Long Island where our diocesan priests are meeting for the 7<sup>th</sup> convocation. According to the literature in the room, the seminary was dedicated in 1930. The bureau in the room certainly is an original piece! The seminary is now a retreat house and has some diocesan offices located in it, but for decades it was the seminary for the diocese of Brooklyn and then for both Brooklyn and Rockville Center. The chapel is very beautiful. It is Romanesque in design with a gorgeous reredos. Underneath is another chapel called the Bishop's Chapel with altars along the side, all of them marble and mosaic. When they built back in the day, they built monumentally. I cannot help think about the hundreds of men who studied in these rooms and filled the chapel for liturgies. Being in a seminary for these days brings back many memories of my own days. Two doors down from me is Fr. Mike Lyons. We met in a parking lot on a January day for a retreat we needed to attend prior to beginning the spring semester at St. John Fisher House, then our diocesan house of discernment. We lived together there and were only doors apart at the seminary in New Jersey for four years. We have been reminiscing and laughing about the events and people we experienced.

The convocation is designed to be a time for the entire presbyterate to be away from our regular duties to pray and celebrate the Eucharist together and reflect. Each day is constructed the same: breakfast, morning prayer, conference, Mass, lunch, free time or attendance at a workshop on the topic of OCIA, Adoration, evening prayer, dinner. The conferences are being given by Msgr. Thomas Caserta, priest of Brooklyn who also is an adjunct professor at St. John University. He has chosen for his talks the theme "The Man of Hope in the Year of Hope." Naturally, he makes references to Pope Francis' bull for the Holy Year, but he extensively quotes St. Paul and the Book of Hebrews and pulls in psychology. I would rank him as the best speaker we have had at these gatherings.

We are celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Sacred Heart Church this weekend. Founded in 1925 to serve the Polish immigrants to Danbury, the parish was staffed until relatively recently by the Franciscans until they turned it over to the diocese. After the merger, there was some talk about canceling the celebration, but the planning committee and I feel that we should not forget the history of

the Sacred Heart community. It deserves to be remembered and celebrated. I am very pleased that Fr. Dennis Mason, the last Franciscan pastor, will be present. Many people will be happy to see him.

Last Saturday, the parish of Our Lady of Aparecida held its celebration of its feast day which is October 12. At last year's dinner, the community honored Bishop Caggiano for his support leading to their creation as a parish. Fr. Leonel approached me saying that the parish wanted me to be their next honoree as they wished to thank me for my hospitality toward the community over the years. In my remarks, I told the attendees that I appreciated their warmth and gratitude, but it was not only me but the people in leadership and all the parishioners of St. Peter's who recognized our oneness in Jesus Christ and in our Catholic faith. Making reference to the words of St. Peter, I added that all of us regardless of our nationality are the living stones of the structure of the Church. By recognizing me, the community of OLA recognizes you.
