### LAUDATO SI

#### MICROPLASTICS

Some microplastics start out as large plastic pieces, slowly eroded by water or exposure to the sun and the elements: others start off as microplastics specifically produced for certain uses. Some are microbeads, created for skin care products. They are very tiny pieces of manufactured polyethylene plastic that are added as exfoliants to health and beauty products, such as some cleansers, toothpaste, facewash, soap and shower cream, says the Royal Society of Chemistry of Great Britain.

Others originate from plastic based fabrics such as polyester and nylon that shed plastic fibers when washed. Several studies have shown synthetic fibers to make up the lion's share of microplastics found in oceans, rivers and lakes and clothes made from synthetics (polyester, acrylic, nylon etc.) are widely implicated as the source of that pollution. In addition, some industrial processes can produce microplastics that can contribute to the problem when mishandled.
