Is it not the same relativistic logic which justifies buying organs of the poor for resale or use in experimentation, or eliminating children because they are not what the parents wanted? This same "use and throw away" logic generates so much waste; because of the disordered desire to consume more than what is really necessary.

We should not think that political efforts will be sufficient to prevent actions which affect the environment because, when the culture itself is corrupt and objective truth and universally valid principles are no longer upheld, then laws can only be seen as arbitrary impositions or obstacles to be avoided.
