





**Note regarding Masks at Masses at St. Richard's and St. Mary's

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is available at St. Mary's and St. Richard's at the following times, or by appointment.

St. Mary: Saturday 3:15 to 3:45 PM in the Reconciliation Room located near the main Church entrance

St Richard: Saturday 3:45 to 4:15pm in the Reconciliation Room located on the left side of the main church

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held monthly at each parish:

St. Richard's: First Sunday of each month 1:00 PM. Parents are asked to contact the rectory to schedule their child's Baptism.

St. Mary's: Third Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. To schedule a Baptism, go to the Collaborative website to fill out an online form. (DanversCatholic.org)

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Engaged couples are invited to contact the Rectory as soon as the decision to marry has been made. Please consider a visit with us before making additional arrangements at least six months in advance of the desired wedding date.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

Please notify us if anyone is ill in the hospital or at home would like to receive the Sacrament of the Sick.






