RCIA is for all non-Catholics who wish to be baptized and Catholics who wish to be received into full communion in the Catholic Church and want to inquire about the Catholic Church. We prepare candidates for the Sacraments of Initiation which are Baptism, Confirmation, First Eucharist. The classes also include preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. During the Inquiry, Catechumenate, Purification & Enlightenment and Mystagogy stages of RCIA we study scripture and doctrine which entails an abundance of knowledge for spiritual growth.

Come and see! Meet with us in an informal setting for coffee to discuss questions you have in the Adult Education room. Parish Registration for Adults

This is a friendly reminder, as we approach certificate of eligibility season, that adults who had previously been (or still are) registered with their parents, should register themselves and their households.

If adult children still live in the Manalapan area and still would like to be active members of the Parish of St. Thomas More, simply register on our website, moremercy.org. If they have moved away, it is the Church in their current area that they should register in, and from which they would obtain a certificate of eligibility to be a Godparent or a Sponsor. Being registered with your local parish is important for receiving the services from the Church, keeping up to date with what's going on, and participating in the life of the community and celebration of the Sacraments.



*We are adopting the military personnel at **Naval Weapons Station Earle** in Colts Neck. There are 286 service members and their families living on the base in 89 housing units. More are stationed there but live in off-base housing. An average seaman starting out only makes about \$3600 a month!*

Unlike most military bases, this base does not have a PX or a commissary where military members and their families can buy discounted food. They are paying FULL PRICE for everything making normal day-to-day living difficult for these very important members of our society. The Red Cross has set up a food pantry on the base to help. They need everything; diapers, wipes, personal hygiene, drinks, water, non-perishable foods etc.

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A priest I know was asked by a door-to-door evangelist, "Do you believe in Jesus?" He answered, "Yes, I do. But if I may ask you," he continued, "Where do you experience Jesus' body and blood?" His interlocutor responded somewhat confusedly, "I don't. I just believe in him. That's all that is needed." Later my priest friend would relate to me, "The more I thought about it, that response struck me as totally inadequate. As human beings, we need to encounter Jesus' body and blood, not just hear about him and mentally believe. Otherwise, Jesus is just a ghost."

This week we see this central point as we arrive at the climactic moment of Jesus' teaching on the Eucharist. Jesus has established the importance of believing in him as the **"bread of life come down from heaven."** Belief deeply matters because it leads to a real, bodily encounter with Jesus through eating and drinking. That's why Jesus emphasizes to an almost outrageous degree the non-metaphorical necessity to **"eat my flesh and drink my blood"** (John 6:54). The real presence of Jesus' body and blood — he himself, truly, really, substantially — has been the Church's treasure since Holy Thursday. Internal belief in the heart *and* the ritual act of eating and drinking the Eucharist, the Church has stubbornly insisted on *both*, not just one or the other.

This is not meant to criticize non-Catholic Christians who deeply trust and love Jesus, nor is it a triumphal elitist claim about the Catholic Mass. Rather it is a humble, trusting acknowledgement that God in Jesus comes to us in a way most proper to human beings: in our hearts and our bodies, faith *and* the Eucharist.

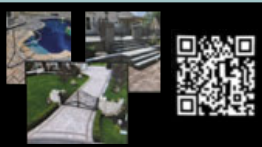
