
Prayer to St. Michael

ROSARY ALTAR 'BABY SHOWER':




The Rosary Altar Society is having a baby 'shower'. As they have done in the past, they are asking all in our



FAITH FORMATION NOTES:
Read the Gospel: Mark 9:2-10

In today's Gospel, Peter, James, and John—often described as the inner circle of disciples—went with Jesus to a high mountain. (*In the Bible, mountains are often places of Divine Revelation.*) The three are so overcome by what they see, hear, and experience that they do not know what to do or say. They simply know that they have witnessed something powerful. Jesus instructed them to tell no one of what they had seen, and they did indeed keep the matter to themselves. This is the opposite of what the leper in the Gospel just two Sundays ago did. He told everyone what happened to him! At the end of each episode of the television series "Blue Bloods," the family gathers around the table for Sunday dinner. No matter the difficulties or discouragements of the week, the ritual of the Sunday meal is honored. At the end of one particularly difficult week the grandfather encouraged the family by saying, "I see the light of God in this family." Perhaps that is a description of the transfiguration, the glory of God, as it is revealed in daily family life. Today take time to think about where you have seen God's glory shine in your family, and in the lives of each of your family members. Take your family for a fifteen-minute walk through your neighborhood today. Enjoy the sun, the clouds, the breeze, the sights, and the sounds of the day. Afterward, gather at your kitchen or dining table for a special Sunday meal and talk about all the ways you saw the glory of God revealed in nature today.

Dear Friends in Christ,

I hope that the first days of Lent have been really great for everyone. It is a wonderful season that we have to prepare to celebrate Jesus' victory over sin and death. I urge everyone in the parish to try to carve out some dedicated time each day or weekly to enrich these wintry days and nights by reading the Bible or one of the prayer books that we offer. You may also try to pray the Rosary or even just meditate on the Sacraments or the saints, etc. There is no shortage of ways in which each of us can be drawn ever more meaningfully into Jesus' Paschal Mystery (His suffering, death and resurrection). I hope too that as many as are able can try to attend Mass—either in person or via our weekly livestream—and be filled with the countless graces that God offers through Mass. In doing so, it will give our Lenten disciplines of prayer, fasting and alms-giving a richer experience and help to make the celebration of Easter ever more rewarding. Give it a try!

A few words about the ongoing Diocesan Appeal. As you may be aware, several changes were made to the Bishop's Appeal, as it used to be called. Among the other changes, in addition to the name, is that all processing of the Appeal is now done in Albany at the main Diocesan office, and no longer here in the parish (which is a great help!) and, the Appeal runs until June—following the fiscal year model—which is also a benefit. With that said, all parishes have been asked to encourage all households in the parish that have not yet made a gift to please do so. As you will appreciate, due to the protracted Covid pandemic, the Appeal has not enjoyed the full support that it otherwise does in terms of gifts being made. If you have not yet given a gift to the Diocesan Appeal, please do so as soon as you are able to. To date, here at St. Michael's, we have received **\$23,831.00** toward our annual goal. As you can see, the total amount of gifts given and the number of gifts are both markedly down from past years. In particular, during Lent, this is an ideal time to lend your support to help our parish reach our annual goal. I urge all those households who have yet made a gift, to please try to do so. Your gift to the Diocesan Appeal will help to ensure that the programs, ministries, services and offices/staffing that benefit so many people throughout our fourteen county wide Diocesan family will be able to be offered and Jesus' ministry will continue, especially as we are still facing so many challenges due to the Coronavirus. If you have any questions, please feel free to call the parish office. Thank you very much.

Don't forget that during the month of March, every Tuesday evening from 5:30 until 6:30, I will be available in the confessional room in church for anyone who wishes to take advantage of the Sacrament of Reconciliation—confession—during Lent. You may also go to confession on Saturdays just before the vigil Mass, from 3:00 until 3:45 pm. Lent is the perfect time to unburden your soul from sin and receive the immense gift of God's loving mercy. All are welcome!

Please be sure to help support the ongoing 'Baby Shower' by the Rosary Altar Society. The donated items will be given to Birthright, which assists babies and their mothers, especially those who are in need. Any baby related items are requested. You may place the items in the pack-n-play that is located near the large door to the school. Thanks so much!


MASS ‘LIVESTREAMED’ WEEKLY! Mass is
