


### 5<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY OF LENT

**CHRISTIAN SERVICE MEMBERS:** Due to the



**FAITH FORMATION NOTES:**

Read the Gospel: **Mark 9:2-10**

In today's Gospel, Peter, James, and John—often described as the inner circle of disciples—went with Jesus to a high mountain. (In the Bible, mountains are often places of Divine Revelation.) The three are so overcome by what they see, hear, and experience that they do not know what to do or say. They simply know that they have witnessed something powerful. Jesus instructed them to tell no one of what they had seen, and they did indeed keep the matter to themselves. This is the opposite of what the leper in the Gospel just two Sundays ago did. He told everyone what happened to him!

At the end of each episode of the television series "Blue Bloods," the family gathers around the table for Sunday dinner. No matter the difficulties or discouragements of the week, the ritual of the Sunday meal is honored. At the end of one particularly difficult week the grandfather encouraged the family by saying, "I see the light of God in this family." Perhaps that is a description of the transfiguration, the glory of God, as it is revealed in daily family life. Today take time to think about where you have seen God's glory shine in your family, and in the lives of each of your family members.

Take your family for a fifteen-minute walk through your neighborhood today. Enjoy the sun, the clouds, the breeze, the sights, and the sounds of the day. Afterward, gather at your kitchen or dining table for a special Sunday meal and talk about all the ways you saw the glory of God revealed in nature today.


The Gospel this week is the miraculous account of Jesus raising Lazarus. John provides us with much to consider in this passage. Ultimately, it is an unequivocal display of Jesus' divine power—that is far greater than just curing someone who is blind, etc.— and it gives us pause to realize that if Jesus does this for Lazarus, how utterly awesome is it when he conquers death. We are invited to think about this and to align our lives in such a way that we, too, like Lazarus, are being called to new life, a life that is filled with the gift of salvation won for us all by Jesus' love and mercy.

Don't forget that anyone who would like to go to confession before Easter are invited to come on Tuesday evening from 5:30 ~ 6:30 pm in church. This is in addition to our regular time for Reconciliation on Saturdays from 3:00 ~ 3:45 before our vigil Mass. In additions, St. Clement Church in Saratoga is having a Lenten penance service THIS Wednesday from 7:00 pm until 8:00 pm.
