





**FAITH FORMATION NOTES:**

Read the Gospel: **John 15:1-8**

Jesus uses the image of a vine and its branches to help his listeners understand the interconnectedness and relationships between God the Father, Jesus, and all followers of Jesus. Jesus is the vine and we, the followers, are the branches that grow from that vine. The way we glorify God is by bearing much fruit and by becoming disciples of Jesus.

Today's Gospel invites you to consider what you are doing in your domestic Church, the Church of your home, to remain connected to the vine (Jesus) and to the vine grower (God the Father). Have any attitudes, behaviors, choices, or practices crept into family life and weakened or broken your connection to Jesus, the vine? If so, what can you do to re-establish or strengthen the connection?

Bring your "Reflection for Parents" into a family discussion of what you are doing to remain strong in your connection to the vine (Jesus) and to the vine grower (God the Father). Then talk about things that are happening that could potentially weaken your connection to Jesus, the vine. For example, the Sunday sports schedule is taking precedence over attending Sunday Mass and religious education classes. Or, the busy pace of weeknights has crowded out time for family prayer at the end of the day. Make a plan to re-energize your connection to the vine, and work together to accomplish the plan!

**DISCUSSION STARTERS:**

Use today's discussion time to take a walk together. Notice new growth on the trees and bushes, and pause in your walk to name ways you are growing in faith and bearing good fruit. Continue walking, and point out any dead branches or leaves that have fallen away from the trees. Pause to quietly pray for forgiveness for any ways in which you have turned away from Jesus, the vine.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Gosh, it's amazing that we're in the month of May already! Let's hope that the April showers we had will bring May flowers (*and a little warmer weather, too!*) May is a great month for a number of reasons. First, it is the month dedicated to our Blessed Mother, Mary. As the mother of Jesus, or *Τηροτοκος*, she offers us an example of how we may bring Jesus into the world. May is also the month when we celebrate our Mothers—on Mother's Day—next Sunday! We also commemorate all our mom's who are with the Lord in Heaven. It's mind-boggling that this year marks 40 years since my mom died, in 1981. My siblings and I miss her, but, we know that she is enjoying the glory of God forever. May is also a good time to take a moment and reflect on our stewardship in support of our parish. I encourage all in our parish to think about how you might be able to maybe do a more in terms of sharing your time, talents and, yes, treasure. I am grateful to those who have stepped up to the plate by giving the school kitchen a fresh painting; I am appreciative for the help given to repair and improve some things that have needed attention. I am especially grateful to everyone who has been so remarkably generous with your financial gifts each week. Please continue to do your best with your church offerings, it makes a big difference! If you have skills that you can offer that might benefit our parish in any way, please let me know! Remember, it's not C H R C H without U. Thank you!

Lastly, there's something that has been nagging me the past month or so. It has to do with the status of various Covid restrictions that have been 'relaxed' by the Governor. For example, he has increased the capacity limits for numerous 'venues' in the past weeks since before Easter. Curiously, amid the different relaxations, casinos, theaters, stadiums, restaurants, bars, nursing homes, hospitals and such have all seen an increase in the percentage of persons who may be admitted, churches and houses of worship have been conspicuously omitted. It's not fair! It is most troubling and I encourage all to contact the Governor's office to request churches and houses of worship be given similar consideration. Think about it: if it's safe for Yankee Stadium to open, it is most assuredly safe for a church to be given more capacity limits. One wonders why this is the case...? Blessings to you!
