
### DO YOU PLAY AN INSTRUMENT? If you or





**FAITH FORMATION NOTES:**

**Read the Gospel: *John 17:11b-19***

In today's Gospel passage, Jesus is praying for his disciples. He asks his Father to keep them in his name, to make them one, to protect them from the evil one, and to consecrate them in the truth. He acknowledges that while his disciples are in the world, they do not belong to the world. They are, however, sent into the world to share the Good News they have seen and heard.

In a way, Jesus is talking with his heavenly Father about passing on the mission, the work of the Church, to the next generation of leaders—the disciples. Our children are our next generation. They are the ones who will carry on the rituals, traditions, stories, and yes—the faith—that you have taught them and shared with them. Take time to think about the ways in which you are handing on the traditions, rituals, and stories of your Catholic faith. What more can you do to prepare your children, the next generation, to go out into the world to share the Good News?

Dear Friends in Christ,

We're in the home stretch now for this Easter season. Next week the Church celebrates Pentecost—the 'birthday' of the Church with the gift of the Holy Spirit. We just celebrated the Feast of the Ascension which marks Jesus' return to Heaven in advance of sending the Holy Spirit. Throughout the Easter season, we have heard God's Word which reminds us about the beginnings of the Church in the first decades following Jesus' Passion and how our spiritual ancestors wrestled with challenges, setbacks and disappointments which could have scuttled the growth of the Faith. Thanks be to God, that was not the case back then, and, at least as importantly today, I hope the same will be true. One of my concerns, as we slowly emerge from the constraints of the Covid-19 Pandemic, is that we have 'lost' many members of our parish, indeed, of the Faith and the Church. I am hopeful that my worry about this is unfounded and that there will be a surge of the Faithful returning to Mass once things are able to resume some semblance of 'normal'. I have been delighted to see more parishioners returning to Mass over the past weeks since Easter Sunday. I'm confident that as more people receive the Covid-19 vaccines attendance at Masses will continue to increase. I am confident too that some folks are anxious to return to Mass in person, having been unable to attend due to the health concerns. Let's be hopeful, as the Easter people we call ourselves, that as much in life as in spirit, we are moving in the right direction, ultimately to all that God offers us in the hope of Heaven.

The Diocese has asked all parish leaders to give the ongoing Diocesan Appeal a boost. As you may recall, last year the Diocese made several major changes to this annual appeal that helps to fund all the various ministries, offices, programs, staffing and related personnel that benefit all of us throughout the Diocese. The name of the Appeal was changed and the way in which it is processed was overhauled, with much of it being done in Albany. A letter has been mailed to those families and households that we have not heard from yet for this year's Appeal, which runs through June 30. Please support the Appeal with your gift. 
**STATUE OF SAINT MICHAEL FOR OUTSIDE:** Recently, an opportunity for the parish to purchase an outdoor statue of our parish patron, Saint Michael the Archangel, was presented to Father Tony. Such an addition to our parish grounds would be a wonderful gift. The total cost would be approximately \$3,000.00 (*give or take, depending on the shipping*). Many inquiries about having such a statue outside have been made over the years. There is an indoor statue of Saint Michael, located above the Baptismal font, yet most people never see it due to the odd location of the statue. Father Tony invites parishioners to donate toward the cost of this to defray the overall total price. If you would like to make a donation or any amount toward the price of this statute, in honor or memory of a loved one(s), please call the parish office and/or speak with Father Tony. Having an outdoor statue of Saint Michael would be a wonderful addition to our parish facilities, as most parishes do have such a statue somewhere on the outdoor area. If we are able to purchase this statue, it would be located on the outside lawn in front of the main church door entrance (the stained glass door entrance). **IMPORTANT MASS STIPEND UPDATE:**



Recently, the Diocese made a change in the amount requested for a Mass intention. For decades, the offering has remained the same, \$10.00 per Mass. Following consultation with the priests and others, it was decided that the amount should be increased to \$15.00 per mass effective NEXT Sunday, May 23, Pentecost. This change was authorized by the Bishop and applies to all parishes effective next Sunday. The amount of the offering for a Mass intention has not increased in a long time. For centuries, Mass offerings have been the primary source of income for priests as part of their salary. This will apply to Mass intentions being requested from May 23 and going forward. If this is a hardship, the offering may be waived and has been done so frequently over the years. Never let the offering prevent you from having a Mass intention offered for someone. If you have any questions about this, please feel free to see Father Tony. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

In addition, just another reminder that due to the Covid-19 pandemic, there has been a marked reduction in Mass intentions overall, especially for daily Masses celebrated Tuesday through Saturday mornings. You may have noticed that in any given week, there are Masses without any specific intention(s) for that day. If there is no intention, a priest should offer the Mass for his own intentions or that of the entire parish. The norm is that there be at least one specific Mass intention if possible. Thus, if you would like to have a Mass offered someone—either living or deceased during the week—please call the office or speak with Father Tony and we will be happy to schedule your special Mass intention(s).

An announced Mass intention is a wonderful gift that anyone may give to honor and celebrate the life of loved ones. Usually a Mass intention is for someone who has died, but, a Mass may also be celebrated for anyone. If you have any questions, call the parish office 518-792-5859.


