




FAITH FORMATION NOTES:

Read the Gospel: **Luke 1:39-56**

Today's Gospel contains the account of the Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth and of Mary's proclamation of the Magnificat. Joy runs through this Gospel reading—the joy as the cousins meet and embrace; the joy as the baby within Elizabeth's womb leaps at the sound of Mary's voice; and the joy expressed in the words of the Magnificat.

Family schedules are full. It may some days seem as if life is one endless carpool from one practice to the next, from one errand to another. In the middle of the stuff of everyday life, today's Gospel encourages us to find cause to rejoice. Sit still for a few moments today and consider where you have experienced joy in recent days. Think about how you can bring joy to others in the week to come. Consider if, in all the events on the family calendar, there is a need to make more room for joy.

The Gospel today also speaks of the power of friendship. Mary and Elizabeth were not only cousins; they were friends. Invite family members to think of friends they haven't seen or spoken with in awhile. Encourage each person to decide on a random act of kindness he or she can do for that friend—something he or she can make, say, or do to let that friend know the he or she is remembered and appreciated.

2. Something that brings me great joy is . . .
3. I want to praise God today because . . .

The RCIA process emphasizes personal conversion and commitment to the Catholic way of life. Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven. It is a very special celebration! The official Doctrine of Mary's Assumption was declared in 1950 by Blessed Pope Pius XII. In short, it states what was otherwise widely believed and accepted that *"We proclaim and define it to be a dogma revealed by God that the immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever virgin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven."* In declaring this, it also says much about you and I in regard to our Faith in the Resurrection of Jesus, Mary's Son and how we can hope to share with her in Heavenly glory. This should give us all a great sense of joy. Think about it; in saying that Mary is alive, fully, in Heaven, how can it be that we would not likewise come to experience that same gift, which is promised through Baptism and reaffirmed by God's love that we share in the Eucharist—aka the Bread of Life—and all that means for us as we anticipate this. It really is a great gift that we have the celebration and I hope that it offers us all a much needed perk amid all the challenges and difficulties that life is hitting us all with. Ave Maria!

I want to invite you to join us for a Bible study later in the fall. We have not offered a Bible study on the Scriptures in some time and I feel that now is a good time to do so. At this point, it seems that Wednesday afternoons may be the best day and time to offer this. It will be based on the Sunday readings. COVID-19 UPDATE: On Thursday, August 5, the Diocese of Albany sent an email to all parish leaders to communicate the request to all parishioners in the Diocese that the use of face masks is being requested again when attending Mass by everyone—




regardless of vaccine status—as a means of mitigating the rampant spread of new Covid-19 Delta variant. As reported widely in the news, there is a significant increase in Covid-19 cases. It is critically essential that everyone does their part, as responsible and well-informed members of society, as well as our parish family, to ensure we take all reasonable precautions to help put an end to the deadly pandemic that continues to impact us all. Guidance from the *Centers for Disease Control*, as well as New York State, Saratoga County all strongly recommending that ALL persons wear a mask—regardless of vaccine status—when in certain areas or in large group settings, such as in-person Mass attendance, in order to break the chain of infection and stop the spread of the virus. I lovingly urge all in our parish to please wear a mask when attending Mass in person. Additionally, all persons who are eligible to get the Covid-19 vaccine are urged to get it. It would be a cruel shame if we lose all the ground that has otherwise been covered in the past seventeen months because of a lack of vaccination! The new strain of Covid-19—the Delta variant—is extremely lethal and is more easily transmitted. Sadly, the majority of those who are contracting the new strain are those who had not gotten the vaccine. New cases of it are increasing almost exponentially! Getting the vaccine is an act of Christian love so please get it ASAP. Thank you!




