





**FAITH FORMATION NOTES:**

Read: [Mark 7:31-37](#)

In today's Gospel, the people brought to Jesus a deaf man who also had a speech impediment. They begged Jesus to heal the man. Jesus touched the man's ears and tongue, and prayed that his ears be opened. Immediately, the man was healed. Jesus ordered the people not to tell anyone, but they could not contain the good news of the man's healing. In the *Rite of Baptism* we pray: The Lord Jesus made the deaf hear and the dumb speak. May he soon touch your ears to receive his word, and your mouth to proclaim his faith, to the praise and glory of God the Father. Amen. (*Rite of Baptism* 101)

Read again today's Gospel. Listen—truly listen—for its meaning in your life and in the life of your family. What do you hear the Spirit of God speaking to your heart? Who needs to hear the Good News of this reading? How will you share this Good News with those who need to hear?

Begin by inviting family members to respond to the following open-ended statements.

1. With my ears I can . . .
2. With my voice I can . . .

Invite family members to share what they think it would be like to not be able to hear or speak. What sounds would they most miss hearing? What would they most miss doing with their voices? Together, offer spontaneous prayers of thanks to God for the gifts of hearing and speech, and pray for all who need healing of body, mind, or spirit.

**DISCUSSION STARTERS:**

In place of questions, create two lists for the family fridge or two posters to place on or near the family prayer table. Label the lists or the posters With My Ears I Heard and With My Voice I Said. Invite family members to write things they hear and say in the coming week that express faith in God and love for God and neighbor. For example: "With my ears I heard the birds singing" or "With my voice I said thanks to Dad."

If you are unable to do so yet, please know that you are missed and that we are anxious for you to join us again soon, hopefully. We continue to 'livestream' our weekly 4:00 pm vigil Mass via our YouTube channel and all are welcome to join with us in prayer at Mass that way each week. Regarding our ministries, well, frankly, we cannot do them without YOU! Since we re-opened for public Masses, we have only had a small fraction of the regular complement of liturgical ministers returning to help out at Masses. I am very concerned about this, in addition to the lack of response for our other ministries, too, not the least of which is our wonderful parish Bereavement Ministry. As of now, we are not able to resume this service to the community. I implore all who were previously involved, and invite anyone new to please let us know if you are willing to assist with this ministry as soon as possible. Please call the office to confirm this at 5418-792-5859. Thank you for your kind support of our parish and ministries!

Our Faith Formation program will resume classes on Sunday, September 26. All families with school age children are encouraged to register the children now. For more information, please contact either Jim Gorman or Mary Stearns with any questions regarding our Faith Formation program. This is for both youth and adult Faith Formation offerings. On Sunday, September 19 we will open our Faith Formation program as we observe Catechetical Sunday. We will have a formal commissioning of our catechists who give so generously of their time to pass on the Faith to the next generation. All volunteers who help as catechists are invited to the 10:00 am Mass on Sunday September 19 for this special liturgy. Also, for any adults, there are two programs which may be of interest for folks: the R.C.I.A and Adult Confirmation. Our R.C.I.A. program will begin on Wednesday, September 1 at 6:30 pm in the parish meeting room. Please call our Faith Formation office at 518-792-5859 to speak with either Jim or Mary. **VACCINATION CLINIC SCHEDULED:** Saratoga County Public Health Services has contacted Father Tony about holding a community vaccination clinic here in the parish hall on Thursday 16. At this time, we are not sure which vaccines will be available, who will be eligible or if they are for first or second doses or booster shots. We will share more information as it becomes available. **COVID-19 UPDATE:** The Diocese of Albany requests the use of face masks again when attending Mass by everyone, regardless of vaccine status. Guidance from the *Centers for Disease Control*, as well as New York State and Saratoga County all strongly recommend that ALL persons wear a mask, regardless of vaccine status, in large group settings, such as in-person Mass attendance, in order to break the chain of infection and stop the spread of the virus. Sadly, the majority of those who are contracting the new strain are those who had not gotten the vaccine.


**SPECIAL COLLECTION TO AID HAITI:**




