## TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### NEW RULE ALLOWING TITLE X FUNDS FOR ABORTION CALLED 'OFFENSIVE' TO MILLIONS

WASHINGTON --- The Catholic News Service reported that the Biden administration's decision to allow Title X family planning funds go to health facilities that perform and promote abortion "is offensive to tens of millions of Americans," said the president of National Right to Life. "The vast majority of Americans believe that using taxpayer funds to pay for abortion is wrong," Carol Tobias said in a statement. Her comments came in a statement released late Oct. 4 in response to the Biden administration's announcement that it had officially reversed the Trump-era "Protect Life Rule" enforcing Title X's ban on taxpayer funds from being used to promote or provide elective abortions. On Jan. 28, eight days after he was inaugurated, President Joe Biden announced he would rescind the Trump-era rule. He stated this in his "Presidential Memorandum to Protect and Expand Access to Comprehensive Reproductive Health Care," which also included his actions to rescind the "Mexico City policy," which blocked U.S. funding for nongovernmental organizations that perform or actively promote abortion as a form of family planning in other nations. Biden, a "Catholic" who supports legal abortion, said the "Protect Life Rule" placed "onerous requirements on abortion providers." The Title X provision enforced by President Donald Trump "draws a bright line between abortion and family planning," the chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' Committee on Pro-Life Activities said. The Biden administration's proposed rule to rescind this "is terrible policy," said Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann of Kansas City, Kansas, the chairman. "It would reintegrate abortion into what is supposed to be a pre-pregnancy family planning program." "In spite of explicit prohibitions in federal law and clear congressional intent that abortion may not be a part of this program, it has repeatedly been coopted by abortion supporters as a funding stream for organizations, programs and facilities that directly promote and provide abortions," the archbishop said. He called on Biden "to suspend this proposed rule and leave the Title X program as it was intended and authorized to be — a program entirely separate from abortion." Tobias said in her statement that "far from uniting this nation, the Biden administration has done everything it can to divide it by facilitating abortion on demand."

A day after Biden announced his intention to reverse the Trump-era Title X rule, Archbishop Naumann noted in a Jan. 29 statement that in addition to "explicitly prohibiting taxpayer funding for abortion," the original authors of Title X "further emphasized this intent by stating that 'the funds authorized under this legislation (shall) be used only to support preventive family planning services, population research, infertility services, and other related medical, informational and educational activities.'"

### COLORADO VANDALS DEFACE CATHOLIC CATHEDRAL

Vandals desecrated the Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Denver, Colorado, last Sunday with satanic messages shortly before the morning Mass. The cathedral's brass front doors and stone columns were defaced with messages mocking Jesus, maligning Catholic priests, and claiming "Satan lives here." According to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), at least 97 acts of vandalism have occurred against Roman Catholic churches across 29 states since May 2020.

### CALIFORNIA ROLLS BACK ASSISTED-SUICIDE SAFEGUARDS

CALIFORNIA — California Catholic Conference had been strongly urging opposition to the legal change. "S.B. 380 does not offer genuine protection to patients and their families, nor does it ensure quality, equitable care for all," the Catholic Conference wrote. "We must protect vulnerable persons in times of weakness — the poor, elderly, people with disabilities, and others in vulnerable groups — from indifference, prejudice, abuse, exploitation, devaluation and psychological and financial pressure to end their lives." Assisted suicide was legalized in California in 2015 by the End of Life Option Act, implemented under then-Gov. Jerry Brown. That act originally included a sunset clause and a legislative evaluation in 2026.

Existing California law required patients to make two separate requests, a minimum of 15 days apart, for assisted-suicide medication. The law signed Oct. 5 shortens the required waiting period between the requests to 48 hours.

The new law also eliminates a requirement that the patient requesting assisted suicide make a "final attestation."

The new law requires a health-care provider who is unable or unwilling to participate in assisted suicide to inform the patient that they do not participate, document the date of the individual's request and the provider's notice of their objection, and transfer their relevant medical record upon request. Previously, health-care providers who objected to assisted suicide were not required to refer patients to a provider who did not object. "Stripping safeguards from the original assisted-suicide law proves what opponents of assisted-suicide laws have always claimed: that limitations on assisted suicide wouldn't last for long once it was legalized," Matt Vallière, executive director of Patients Rights Action Fund, an anti-assisted suicide organization, said Oct. 6. "What California did yesterday lacked compassion and understanding. The effects of this law will be felt for years to come as people throughout the disability and aging community struggle to access quality health care." The conference noted that California's assisted-suicide law passed in the first place in part because of the safeguards and because of the sunset clause; the newly passed law extends the sunset clause to 2031. There is "no data or science" to support the removal of such safeguards, the *Orange County Register* has noted. The Catholic Conference has criticized the lack of data collected and a lack of transparency in the law's implementation. Annual reports on the End of Life Option Act do not include any information on the reasons for patients requesting the lethal drugs.


