

TENEBRAE - A SERVICE OF DARKNESS

You are invited to participate in Tenebrae which will combine Matins and Lauds from the Divine Office on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday at 8:30 AM. "Tenebrae" means "darkness" which is basically a funeral service for Our Lord.

HOLY THURSDAY

Procession and Adoration

During the evening of Holy Thursday, the Mass of the Lord's Supper will be celebrated at 7:00 pm. It is celebrated in the evening because the Passover began at sundown. After the Communion prayer, there is no final

blessing. The Holy Eucharist is carried in procession through the Church and then transferred into a place of reposition. This year, the Repository will be in the Parish Hall. The hymn *Pange Lingua* is sung at this time. In honor of the institution of the Eucharist, many Catholics visit repositories for the Eucharist in seven Churches. (This tradition goes back to the pilgrims' visits to the seven principal churches of Rome.) After the Mass, we recall the Agony in the Garden and the arrest and imprisonment of Jesus. The altar is stripped bare, crosses are covered, the Eucharist will be placed on the altar of repose. The Parish Hall will be open for silent adoration to answer Christ's invitation, "Could you not then, watch one hour with me?" from 8:00 PM until 10:00 PM.

GOOD FRIDAY



On Good Friday, the whole Church mourns the death of our Savior. This is traditionally a day of sadness, spent in fasting and prayer. It is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence. Following the ancient tradition of the Church,

there are no sacraments celebrated on Good Friday or Holy Saturday. Stations of the Cross are prayed at 12:00 Noon, the traditional Hour of the Crucifixion, The Service of the Lord's Passion takes place at 3:00 in the afternoon, the traditional hour of His Death on the Cross. The altar is completely bare with no cloths, candles or cross. The service is divided into three parts: Liturgy of the Word, Veneration of the Cross, and Holy Communion. We will again pray the Stations of the Cross at 7:00 pm.

HOLY SATURDAY



Holy Saturday

On Holy Saturday, we commemorate Christ in the tomb. There is no celebration of the sacraments until the Easter Vigil at 8:00 PM. Although we are still mourning, there is much preparation on this day in anticipation of Easter.

RECONCILIATION MONDAY APRIL 11th ~ 2 to 4 & 6 to 9 PM

Here at St. Augustine Parish. the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed and Confessions will be heard from 4 to 8 PM. It is a great thing to hear about God's merciful love. It is even better to experience it ~ personally. No matter how long it may have been since your last confession ~ weeks, years or even decades, there is no time like during Lent to know the mercy of God in the Sacrament of Penance. Seize this moment of grace. Bring a friend.

6 Steps for a Good Confession

- 1. Examine your conscience to ascertain which sins you have committed since your last good confession.
- 2. Be sincerely sorry for your sins.
- 3. Confess your sins to the priest. Say: "Bless me Father for I I have sinned, it has been _____ since my last confession. These are my sins...."
- 4. Make certain you confess all of your mortal sins and the number of times you committed each one.
- 5. After your confession, do the penance the Priest gives to you.
- 6. Pray daily for the strength to avoid the occasion of sin especially for those sins you were just absolved from. Say the Act of Contrition before going to bed every night.

ACT OF CONTRITION

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You and I detest all my sins because I dread the loss of Heaven and the pains of Hell, but most of all because they offend You, my God, Who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of your grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to amend my life. Amen.
