BLESSED PIER GIORGIO FRASSATI

Though July 4 is Independence Day in the United States, it is now also the Feast of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. This From Aleteia:

The youthful joy of Bl. Pier Giorgio Frassati remains an inspiration to people of all ages as they await the day when he will be named a saint.

A young Italian known for his social activism, Bl. Pier Giorgio Frassati did not live long, dying at the age of 24, but has since captivated the world. In particular, his love for adventure and the great outdoors has made him an unofficial patron of all mountain climbers and campers. Yet, it was not his survival skills that made him a saint, but his love of the poor that displayed his generous heart and continues to inspire others. No telling of Pier Giorgio's life would be complete without mention of his mother, Adelaide Ametis. She taught the faith to Pier Giorgio and his sister Luciana entirely on her own, as her husband was an agnostic. Clearly she did something right, as her son grew into such a holy young man. Pier Giorgio was known for his practical jokes and sense of fun, to the point that he was jokingly called a "terror." His compassion, however, was legendary, to the point that his many acts of generosity were a source of annoyance to his father.

Frassati carried with him St. Paul's "Hymn of Charity" from the First Letter to the Corinthians. It kept him focused on what truly counts in life and how no matter what he did in this world, if he did not have love, he would have be "a resounding gong or a clashing cymbal." It is a passage that can be recited over and over again, and if we take the time to incorporate it into our lives, there is no limit to the amount of love we can give to the world.

While Bl. Pier Giorgio Frassati is often referred to as the "Man of the Beatitudes," St. John Paul II also named him the "man of our century." He spoke these words at the beatification of Bl. Pier Giorgio Frassati on May 20, 1990:

He is the "interior" man loved by the Father, because he loved much! He is also **the man of our century, the modern man, the man who loved so much!** Isn't love the most necessary thing in our 20th century, at its be ginning as well as at its end? Isn't it true that only this remains, without ever losing its validity: the fact that he "loved"?

St. John Paul II was referring to the 20th century, which was a century marked by many wars and death. Frassati's example of selfless love of other people, especially the poor and most vulnerable, was a beacon of light in the midst of the darkness. Furthermore, "[Frassati] testifies that holiness is possible for everyone and that **only the revolution of charity can kindle the hope of a better future in the hearts of men.**" Frassati's example remains potent in the 21st century and his intercession is repeatedly invoked by young and old alike. A "revolution of charity" is still needed and Frassti can remain the "man of our century."


