TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FATHERLY ADVICE FROM ST. LOUIS OF FRANCE TO HIS SON

From Aleteia

St. Louis, King of France, was not only an exemplary monarch, he was also a remarkable father, desiring the best for his children. Many monarchs in the history of the world were terrible parents, as they essentially let their children be raised by nurses and maids, having nothing to do with them. St. Louis of France, on the other hand, was much more concerned about the upbringing of his children and desired that they lead a good and holy life. This can be clearly seen in a spiritual testament St. Louis wrote to his son, which is featured in the Church's Office of Readings. In it he provides the following five fatherly pieces of wisdom that any father can learn from and can pass on to their children.

1. LOVE GOD WITH YOUR ENTIRE BEING

My dearest son, my first instruction is that you should love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your strength. Without this there is no salvation.

2. ACCEPT ANY TRIAL THAT COMES YOUR WAY

If the Lord has permitted you to have some trial, bear it willingly and with gratitude, considering that it has happened for your good and that perhaps you well deserved it.

3. LEAD A LIFE OF PRAYER

Listen to the divine office with pleasure and devotion. As long as you are in church, be careful not to let your eyes wander and not to speak empty words, but pray to the Lord devoutly, either aloud or with the interior prayer of the heart.

4. LOVE THE POOR

Be kindhearted to the poor, the unfortunate and the afflicted. Give them as much help and consolation as you can... Always side with the poor rather that with the rich, until you are certain of the truth.

5. REMAIN FAITHFUL TO THE CHURCH

Be devout and obedient to our mother the Church of Rome and the Supreme Pontiff as your spiritual father.

St. Louis desired above all else to "practice what he preached," and his children could see that he was not simply Catholic in name, but truly believed every part of his Catholic faith. He is a great intercessor for all fathers who want to provide what is best for their children, especially in the spiritual realm.

WHERE IS CATHOLICISM GROWING IN THE U.S.?

From the National Catholic Register:

Out of the top 10 gainers, only one diocese — the Archdiocese of New York — is located outside of the South or the West. Of the 10, six are in Texas or California. As the number of Catholics in the U.S. has grown by 40% in the past 40 years — from 48 million to 67 million — new hubs of Catholic life have emerged — ranging from booming major metro areas to smaller communities that are punching well above their weight on vocations. Several dioceses in the South and the West, centered on growing cities, have gained literally hundreds of thousands of Catholics in recent decades, to the point where some of those dioceses have found themselves lacking the infrastructure to accommodate the new crush of parishioners. At the same time, many areas of the country once considered Catholic strongholds — particularly the Northeast and the Midwest — have continued, in a decades-long trend, to see their Catholic population atrophy. In 1980, nearly 70% of the nation's Catholics lived in the Northeast or Midwest. By 2000, that percentage was 58%. And by 2019, it was just 47%, Church statistics show.

September 7, 2025 Month of Our Lady of Sorrows CRISIS IN GAZA

Dear friends in the Lord:

The Most Reverend Timothy Broglio, Archbishop for the Military Services, USA and president

of the United States Catholic Conference has written to the bishops of the country asking for prayers and financial support to alleviate the ongoing tragedy in Gaza. Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of Christians and other innocent victims of violence there and surrounding areas who are struggling to survive, protect their children, and live with dignity in dire conditions.

The Holy Father continues to call for a cease fire and for aid to enter the territory, noting with great sorrow that "Gaza is starving".

Given the extraordinary nature of this crisis, I write today announcing a second collection next Sunday, September 14th, the solemnity of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. Funds from this collection will be sent by the archdiocese to Catholic Near East Welfare Association and Catholic Relief Services to provide humanitarian relief and pastoral support for our affected brothers and sisters. The situation cries out for the assistance of the Catholic community in the United States.

As we often see in these situations, our parishioners instinctively want to be involved in the long-term recovery. I know well of the generosity of our people and their deep care for those in distress.

I am grateful, as always, for your participation.
