OTHER SACRAMENTS

RECONCILIATION: Confessions are heard each Saturday from 3:30 – 4 p.m., or any time by appointment.

BAPTISM: Baptisms take place on the third Sunday of each month, following the Noon Mass. Call the office to schedule a date. First-time parents are asked to attend a Baptismal preparation class.

MARRIAGE: Engaged couples seeking to be married at St. Lawrence are asked to contact the parish office one year in advance, due to the meetings needed to prepare for this Sacrament. This should be done before any reception plans.

MINISTRY TO THE SICK OR HOMEBOUND: Call the parish office to make arrangements for a visit from Father (which can also include Anointing and Confession), a Deacon, or an Extraordinary Minister. In the case of hospital stays, patient privacy laws prevent hospitals from releasing names. Please call the office if you, or someone you know, has been admitted.



THE EMPTY TOMB

To us, who have received the fullness of faith, the empty tomb is a comforting thought. But to the holy women and Apostles who discovered it, on that first Easter morning, it was devastating. Not only had the One they had pinned all their hopes and dreams on suffered the death of a criminal, but now His body was possibly stolen. They were confused, scared and very sad. But, when Jesus did appear to them after His resurrection their spirits soared. Jesus, had conquered death! He was alive! The promise of Eternal Life was true. Now, Jesus would go ahead of them and prepare a place for each of them in His Father's Kingdom just as He had promised He would (John 14:1)

This is also the time of year when we remember in a special way our loved ones who have died and have gone on ahead of us. We remember them in our Easter Masses and

probably visit their graves bringing flowers with us. But, do we stop and realize as we stand at those graves that in the real sense, the tombs of our loved ones are also empty? Their bodies may still be there and it is right to show respect for them. However, their immortal souls, the part of them that made them special to us, that made them in the image and likeness of God, has gone to that very place that Jesus told the Apostles about. The empty tomb of that first Easter morning holds a promise for each of us. Because of Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection, the gates of Heaven have been opened and we too have a special place prepared for us in the Father's Kingdom.




