Dear Parishioners,

A young wealthy man came to Jesus because he lacked one thing. He wanted the kind of lasting peace and happiness which money could not buy him. The answer he got from Jesus, however, was not what he was looking for. He protested that he kept all the commandments - but Jesus spoke to the trouble in his heart. One thing kept him from giving himself whole-heartedly to God. While he lacked nothing in material goods, he was nonetheless possessive of what he had. He placed his hope and security in what he possessed. So when Jesus challenged him to make God his one true possession and treasure, he became sad.

Why did he go away from Jesus with great sorrow and sadness rather than with joy? His treasure and his hope for happiness were misplaced. Jesus challenged the young man because his heart was possessive. He was afraid to give to others for fear that he would lose what he had gained. He sought happiness and security in what he possessed rather than in who he could love and serve and give himself in undivided devotion.

Why does Jesus tell his us to "sell all" for the treasure of his kingdom? Treasure has a special connection to the heart, the place of desire and longing. The thing we most set our heart on is our highest treasure. The Lord himself is the greatest treasure we can have. Giving up everything else to have the Lord as our treasure is not sorrowful, but the greatest joy.

Selling all that we have could mean many different things - really anything that might stand in the way of our loving God first and foremost in our lives and giving him the best we can with our time, resources, gifts, and service.

The Gospel for this Sunday presents us with a paradox: we lose what we keep, and we gain what we give away. When we lose our lives for Jesus Christ, we gain a priceless treasure and an inheritance which lasts forever. Whatever we give to God comes back a hundredfold. Generosity flows from a heart full of gratitude for the abundant mercy and grace which God grants. May Jesus be our highest treasure and may nothing in this world keep us away from Him.

Drodzy Parafianie,

Młody bogaty człowiek przyszedł do Jezusa, ponieważ brakowało mu jednego. Chciał trwałego pokoju i szczęścia, których nie mógł kupić za pieniądze. Odpowiedź, jaką dostał od Jezusa, nie była jednak tym, czego szukał. Zapewnił, że zachowuje wszystkie przykazania - ale Jezus mówił o problemach w jego sercu. Jedna rzecz powstrzymywała go od całkowitego oddania się całym sercem Bogu. Nie brakowało mu żadnych dóbr materialnych, jednak był zaborczy w tym, co posiadał. Pokładał nadzieję i bezpieczeństwo w tym, co posiadał. Kiedy więc Jezus rzekł mu, aby uczynił Boga swoim jedynym prawdziwym bogactwem i skarbem, zasmucił się.

Dlaczego ów młody człowiek odszedł od Jezusa z wielkim żalem i smutkiem, a nie z radością? Jego skarb i nadzieja na bycie szczęśliwym były nieuzasadnione. Jezus tak rzekł młodzieńcowi, ponieważ jego serce było zaborcze. Bał się dzielić z innymi, bojąc się, że straci to, co zdobył. Szukał szczęścia i bezpieczeństwa w tym, co posiadał, a nie w tym, kogo mógł kochać i komu służyć i oddawać się w niepodzielnym poświęceniu.

Dlaczego Jezus mówi nam, abyśmy "sprzedali wszystko" dla skarbu Jego Królestwa? Skarb ma szczególne relacje z sercem, miejscem pragnień i tęsknoty. To, na czym najbardziej skupiamy nasze serce, jest naszym najwyższym skarbem. Sam Pan jest naszym największym skarbem, jaki możemy posiadać. Oddanie wszystkiego dla Chrystusa jako naszego skarbu, nie jest smutkiem, ale największą radością.

Sprzedać wszystko, co posiadamy, może oznaczać wiele różnych rzeczy, może oznaczać naprawdę wszystko. Najpierw może oznaczać wszystko to, co w naszym życiu może stać na drodze kochającego Boga, a następnie wszystko to, co możemy Mu ofiarować, nasz czas, bogactwo, talenty i pracę.

Ewangelia na dzisiejszą niedzielę przedstawia nam paradoks: tracimy to, co posiadamy, a zyskujemy to, co dajemy. Kiedy tracimy życie dla Chrystusa, zyskujemy bezcenny skarb i dziedzictwo, które trwa wiecznie. Cokolwiek oddajemy Bogu, wraca do nas stokrotnie. Hojność płynie z serca pełnego wdzięczności za obfite miłosierdzie i łaskę, które Bóg daje. Niech Jezus będzie naszym najwyższym skarbem i niech nic na tym świecie nie oddala nas od Niego.
