Christmas Wafers

Traditional Christmas Wafers are available in the Friary or in the Sacristy, after the 10:00 AM Polish Sunday Mass to anyone who wishes to make use of this age-old custom. The Christmas Wafer is used at an evening meal, preferably on Christmas Eve, but can be used anytime close to Christmas. The family gathers together for the evening meal, and after the blessing, each member breaks a piece of the wafer and shares it with all the other members. In this way each member can be at peace with each other as they prepare to welcome Jesus, the newborn King.

CHRISTMAS NOVENA

The greatest gift we can give to another is a share in the celebration of the mass. If anyone would like to have their loved ones (living or deceased) enrolled in a Novena (9 days) of Masses beginning on Christmas Day, please fill out the "Christmas Flowers" envelope and put it in the collection.
