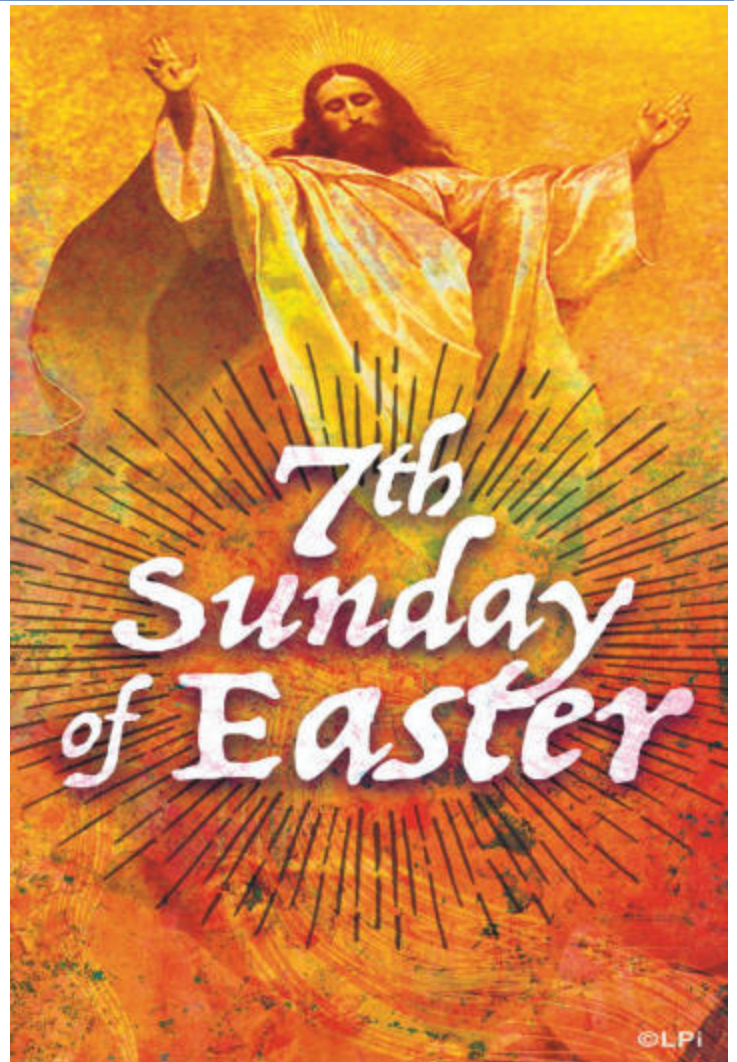

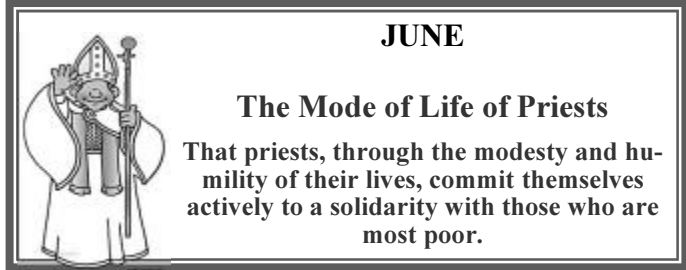

## PARISH NEWS

**FROM THE PASTOR** -- *As many of you know, I applied and was accepted into the Monastic Institute run by the Trappist monks of Mepkin Abbey, South Carolina, furthering a lifelong interest in monasticism. I will be leaving here June 23, living fully as a monk from then until returning to Holy Family on August 1. The Diocese and I are in dialogue about priestly support during this six-week span, and I'm confident that with our great Holy Family pastoral team everyone will remain in good hands.*

*There is a real possibility that I would return to the Abbey for a longer, or even permanent stay, but much depends on the Institute experience, and subsequent discussions with leadership at the Abbey and the Diocese. I do not expect to have outside access during the Institute, but you can follow the summer at the monks' website, [www.mepkinabbey.org](http://www.mepkinabbey.org). But be careful, you may want to book a retreat yourself there some-time and begin your own monastic journey! Peace, Msgr.*

**GRANT AND DONOR UPDATES** - Our Caritas program has received a pledge from a donor for \$5,000, with an additional pledge of lifetime support. More details on this generous expression when we make it public... The Ukulele Summer Camp grant is approximately \$9,000... Through the resources of the New Brunswick Public Schools, repairs and upgrades to our two schools over the summer will result in more than \$100,000 of improvements that will not have to come out of the parish purse.

Holy Father, I pray for not only these alone [the disciples that you gave me], but also for those that will believe in Me through their word." Jn 17:20

Jesus prays for those that will believe and follow Him through the words of the Apostles and disciples before His resurrection and then makes the same point to Thomas, also known as Didymus, when he is absent upon Jesus' appearance to the others after His resurrection in Jn 20:29b.

A belief based on faith is what Jesus is asking of us. However, when do we truly do anything on faith alone?

Well, maybe not as adults, but as children, we were expected to do everything based on faith for our parents. And how disappointing it was when we found out that they didn't always keep their word. We may have started to lose faith and after a while, we may not have believed them at all. Not to mention, if we felt we were smarter than they were, they would not have measured up to our expectations.

Of course, because of human fallibility our words can never compare to Our Lord's words, yet we end up not believing Him as a result of our human experience. These two concepts of believing Our Lord's word and those of our parents would otherwise have no relevance to one another were it not for the image of God within us that starts out pure and undefiled.

As children we are able to believe based on faith alone, because we have an unwavering love for our nurturing parents. But when this love is taken for granted, it leaves scars for the rest of our lives. We become cynical of the world around us and we become our own gods as we see fit to deal with the world and its problems. Faith is no longer an option for us to deal with such problems when we feel wronged in so many ways. In fact, society itself promotes this attitude as a survival tool. God and faith in Him gets left behind and boxed up for those we perceive to be less than us from an intellectual point of view. The thinking is: if we have a high enough intellect, we don't need God or a god to tell us what to do. We are self-sufficient and self-reliant and self-everything ... except for self-depriving. We become self-ish in every way.

So, what does this have to do with faith or believing in God? The same unconditional love we had for our parents as children is what Jesus wants from us now that we have reached adulthood in the faith. Believing in Him is not like having faith in any human person, it is understanding that we are nothing without Him and could not survive without Him, as a child wouldn't survive without its parents. And loving Him unconditionally will show us how to love each other in the same manner.
