PARISH NEWS

WELCOME NEW CLERGY-- In July, we welcome **Fr. Roy Quesea** for a one-month assignment to take the load off our parish team and to give Fr. Quesea an immersion into urban ministry. **Fr. Quesea comes to us in the midst of a break from his advanced academic year studies in canon law in Rome. He speaks English and Spanish and will assist in those liturgies and ministries.** He has helped us in the past for multi-lingual penance services from his previous post at St. Joseph Parish in North Plainfield.

We also welcome new parochial vicar **Fr. Walter Wiktorek**, a priest who will serve our Polish community in the same manner that **Fr. Juhasz** does for the Hungarian community, and with parish-wide responsibilities as well. Fr. Wiktorek has a wide and varied ministerial career, beginning with his time in a Redemptorist seminary in Poland, to missionary work in Bolivia, to various postings in the Metuchen Diocese, including a stint at the former Holy Trinity Parish in Perth Amboy, where our pastor's father, Joe Kerrigan, Sr. served in liturgical ministry for Fr. Wiktorek.

PARISH LEADERSHIP -- After a meeting with diocesan officials, **Deacon Nelson Torres** has been given responsibilities as **administrator of the parish throughout July.** He can be viewed as the same "point of contact" for this period as a pastor would be. Our pastoral team has agreed to not take up any new projects or spending during this time.

JULY 4 HOLIDAY -- The parish center will be closed, and only one Mass will be celebrated, at 9am in English, by Fr. Juhasz at St. Ladislau.

Reflection on the Gospel Reading

And he sent messengers on ahead, who went into a Samaritan village to get things ready for him; but the people there did not welcome him, because he was heading for Jerusalem. When the disciples James and John saw this, they asked, "Lord, do you want us to call fire down from heaven to destroy them?" But Jesus turned to them and rebuked them; [*and said, "You do not know what sort of spirit with which you speak. For the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them."] Lk 9:52-55

* this is what is to be understood from Jesus' response. But the Apostles' response is typical of how we might answer and how we might treat others when we feel self-righteous and above those that are not "in the know". We feel compelled to just write them off, use our power over them or exploit their helpless condition to rid ourselves of their annoyance. We feel indifferent towards them when they seem so far from understanding.

It is however, just the opposite of what Jesus wants of us. He wants us to add compassion where there is none and feel compassion when we are confronted by hate. It is of ourselves that we must sacrifice or give up so that others are to be saved. Is this not what Christ has done for us? If we are to imitate Him, we must use the Spirit He has left with us (that is, also of Him) to overcome our own challenges (as Saint Paul reminds us in Gal 5:14-18), as well as those of society as a whole.

Of course, Saint Paul also reminds us that, if mankind was able to live by "The Great Commandment", there would be no need for the Mosaic Law or laws in general. But we know that there is much work to be done yet for that to be the case and we must first accept that responsibility.
