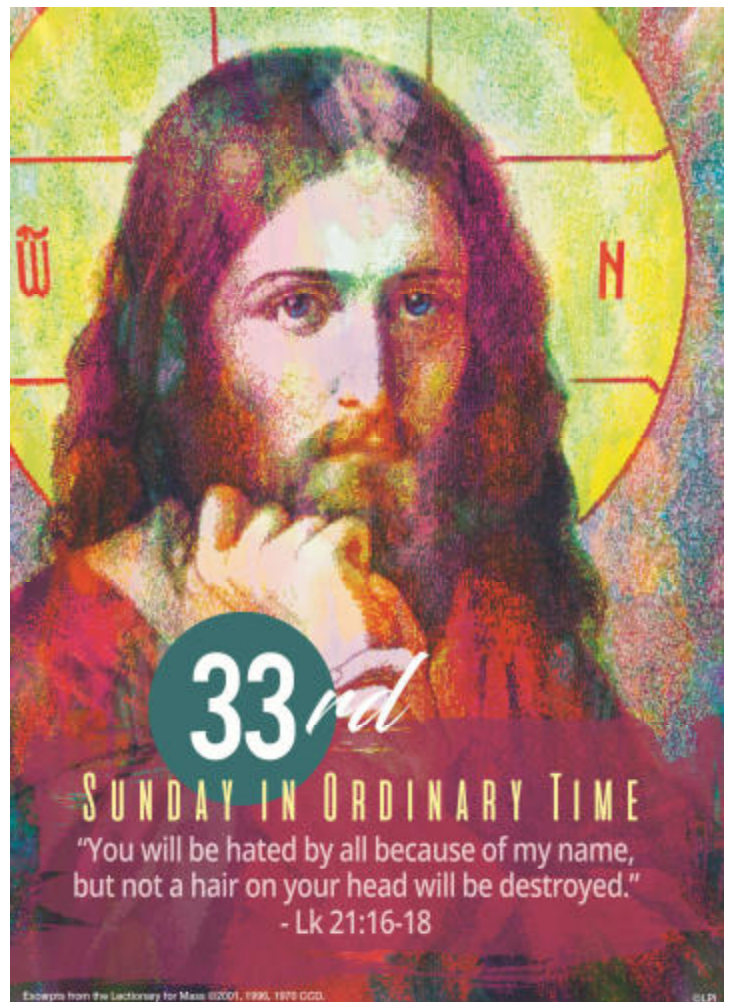

**“By your perseverance will you ensure your lives”  
Lk 21:19**

It is always noteworthy to hear of people in our community that have accomplished or are still actively working at a job, career, position or duty that has spanned five, ten, twenty and even thirty plus years. What ever they have chosen to do, they keep at it until they are compelled to change due to other circumstances. Of course, they may have had other opportunities to make changes possibly the offer of higher wages or salary, however consistency, habit or comfort of knowing something well keeps them fixed and steadfast where they are experts and senior members of their line of work. This also commands some degree of respect towards these people for toughing it out where others become bored, restless and overconfident or even supercilious towards those around them, making it necessary to bring about change in the work and community environment. We hear things like: “He spent his whole life dedicated to the research and cure for cancer.”

“She has been president of that company for so long that it practically defines her life.”

“His commitment to his duties has gained him the respect of his peers.”

Yet, as much as we look up to these people, we still don't understand our conscience, which somehow disapproves of lengthy commitments to worldly duties certainly in lieu of a cost of living.

Maybe, it has to do with the commitment to a goal that seems unexciting or un-gravitating to us. Because while the rest of us are floundering around in life trying to seek out that comfort of a steady income, they seem to have found their calling.

Or maybe, it is the calling part that is missing in our lives. Because, what ever we have decided to work towards, it should work towards bringing us closer to our salvation with Him. And to finally say as St. Paul does, “I have fought the good fight; I have run the good race; I have kept the faith.” **2Tm 4:7** requires great determination, resolve and perseverance of faith in Jesus Christ, Our Lord, in whom everlasting life rests.
