2020 ANNUAL CATHOLIC SOCIAL MINISTRY GATHERING: It is an annual gathering of social ministry leaders who respond to social challenges and issues impacting human dignity, family life, e. g. health and basic human needs, separation, as well as, incarceration, among so many other things. The social ministry leaders who attend come from different backgrounds; they are united, however, by their response to God's call to love, care for, and protect the vulnerable and the less fortunate in the communities they serve. Their faith serves as their anchor and inspiration. Our very own parochial vicar, Fr Walter Wiktorek, together with Miryam Gonzalez, our parish case manager, Jennifer Herrera, our pastoral assistant and youth empowerment specialist, as well as, Lizette Moreno, Faith Formation facilitator, attended the subject gathering held in Washington DC last January 25 – January 28. They were among 600 plus attendees whose lives were impacted by prayer, call to holiness, Catholic social justice teachings and unity in diversity through advocacy.

*A Sunday Reflection
by István Horváth*

**“You are the salt of the earth. [who work and reveal God’s truths through the work of the Spirit]”
Mt 5:13a**

“You are the light of the world. ... your light must shine before men, that they may see the good that you do and give glory to [God], the Father.” Mt 5:14a,16

What a BIG responsibility! Are we up to the task? Where do we even start? Let’s try starting at home in our own families, schools and church communities.

We don’t need to go very far or to search long to do good deeds for others. In fact, Saint Therese of the Child Jesus showed us how we can work towards holiness by the little deeds that we perform and offer up with love for others everyday. We can affect the souls of even the un-believers and change for the better the lives of those we meet through prayer, sacrifice and suffering.

Isaiah also gives us some clues to good deeds as he instructs: “share your bread with the hungry, ... clothe the naked when you see them, and don’t turn your back on your brethren.” Is 58:7 “Then your light shall rise in the darkness, ... Then the Lord will guide you always and satisfy your thirst in parched places, [and] will give strength to your bones.” Is 58:10b,11a

Becoming the “salt of the earth” requires dedication sacrifice and understanding, but most of all love as an imitation of Christ, agape. These traits we can only acquire through the gift of the Holy Spirit within us. Possessing the Spirit of God also bears the responsibility of proclaiming God’s truths to the world. It is through this action of proclaiming God’s truths in the person of Jesus Christ and saving others that we are saved ourselves. Mk 16:15-16, Col 4:4-6, 1Cor 9:19-23, Jas 5:19-20
