MINISTRY IN THE SPOTLIGHT...

CARITAS PROGRAM: The Caritas program of Holy Family Parish responds to basic human needs and provides opportunities for physical and emotional healing and wellness. The Caritas program uses trauma-informed modalities to aid individuals and families therapeutically and utilizes goal-oriented groups to render larger solutions to common community concerns.

WOMEN'S JUSTICE CIRCLES

Women's action groups centered on empowerment and community organization designed to target pressing justice issues, follows an 8-week curriculum from the inter-community Peace and Justice Center.

TEENS WHO CARE JUSTICE INITIATIVE

It is a collaborative project with local and parish teens and various New Brunswick agencies; they discuss youth justice issues.

WOMEN'S CRAFT GROUP

Led by Mrs. Lydia Torres, wife of our very own Deacon Nelson Torres, the Women's Craft Group usually meets every Monday from 6PM to 9PM in the Sacred Heart Church Hall. They spend time crafting and exploring women's issues. Please call the parish center for details.

ZUMBA

Sponsored by St. Peter's Hospital, 7 free weekly classes are offered on the parish campus to encourage healthy and fit lifestyles.

COMMUNITY MOBILE HEALTH CLINIC in PARTNERSHIP with St PETER'S HOSPITAL

The parish connects the community to health services offered by St. Peter's University Hospital at the parish site. These events include screenings for hypertension & diabetes, flu vaccinations for adults and visits from the Community Mobile Health Clinic which provides primary care appointments at the parish campus. Additionally, the parish has become a site where community members can apply for Charity Care coverage at St. Peter's Hospital and Clinics.

*A Sunday Reflection
by István Horváth*

Jesus says, “Let your words be ‘Yes, yes, and No, no.’ Anymore than this is the work of the evil one.” Mt 5:37 “Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or prophets. I have come not to abolish, but to fulfill [and perfect] it.” Mt 5:17

By the statements above, Jesus is telling us that the Mosaic Law and the words of the prophets are from God Himself. It is nothing less than God’s instructions to man in order for man to stay in communion with Him. Moreover, the Teachings of Jesus in His Sermon on the Mount is all of the Old Testament rolled into three basic principles for his disciples: how to behave and live one’s life in the presence of God, how to know, praise (or love) and serve God, and how to treat others as if they were Jesus, Lord and God. Mt 5-7

It is this simple and so difficult at the same time. Our answer to Him – “Yes, yes” – and to the Devil – “No, no” – Everything is that profoundly clear and stark with God: black and white, yes and no, light and darkness. There is no in between! No gray, no sliding scale, no maybe! There is only yes or no.

Wow, that hits home. I don’t always feel like yes or no. Yet, that is what God wants of us in each and every decision we make. This is our “free will”. To obey His Commandments or not; to have life with Him or not.

Sir 15:11-20

Therefore, “Fear of the Lord” is an important gift of the Spirit that deters us from bad choices and helps form a healthy conscience in our heart.

It is not easy to become the “salt of the earth,” but once we are there it is our duty to persevere even at the cost or sacrifice of our own pleasure. It is this sacrificial love or agape with which we treat others that helps us understand God’s love for us. How we choose to profit from our talents is our choice, but sharing our talents with the world is the decision God wants us to choose in accepting His will as ours and answering His call with “Yes, yes”, I want to do Thy will, and “No, no”, what I was doing is not important.

Proclaiming God’s truths to the world takes many forms as in the uniqueness of each individual’s soul, however, recognizing this responsibility in our lives and putting it into actions is the true calling towards holiness. It is through this action of proclaiming God’s truths in the person of Jesus Christ that we sanctify His creation and lead others and ourselves to salvation.
